¹Of the 55,557 cases, 22,682 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (drugs). Of these, 22,566 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communications Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 21,068 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 21,068 cases, 101 were excluded due to one or more of the following reasons: missing drug type (60) or missing acceptance of responsibility information (42). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
