

U.S. MARINE CORPS VOTING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM BEST PRACTICES

1. The following is a list of some of the best practices provided by Marine Corps Bases and Stations used to heighten the awareness of the voting program within the Corps.

a. Disseminated voting information via electronic mail.

b. Disseminated voting information and voting articles via base newspapers and command bulletin boards.

c. VAO's have been added to the check in/check out sheet for Marines arriving at and leaving duty stations.

d. Set up voting awareness stations outside of MCCA facilities (gym, exchange, commissary, etc).

e. Conducted voting training during Marine Battle Skills Training (MBST).

f. The "Absentee Voting" video was aired on base television stations. The Armed Forces Network (AFN) radio and television was utilized to distribute information regarding voting.

g. Utilized the Key Volunteer Network (KVN) to pass voting information to family members.
