

## Kathleen Richardson's 2004 Cross FL Bike Ride for Pulmonary Hypertension

What would you do if you got out of breath when you stood up and walked across a room? Perhaps you would think you're out of shape or maybe you were developing asthma. Most people would not think that they had a life-threatening illness. But that's what Pulmonary Hypertension (also known as PH) is like.

PH is a rare, often misdiagnosed, disease which creates an abnormally high blood pressure in the artery going to the lungs. As a result not enough oxygen gets where it needs to be. The heart then tries to work harder which increases the blood pressure even more. The stress on the heart can eventually lead to heart failure. It is a dangerous, progressive disease for which there is no

known cure. Early diagnosis is very important to treatment. Unfortunately, many doctors are not yet aware of this disease and that delays diagnosis and treatment.

PH patients often require oxygen just for daily activity. Advanced stages of the disease require the patient to use a 24 hour/day IV drug pump. And in some cases, lung transplantation is used.

Kathleen Richardson lives in Ocoee, FL and was diagnosed with PH in 2001. With her current treatments, she is doing extremely well. To help increase awareness of this disease and raise money for research, she and her husband are going to ride their bikes across Florida from the Atlantic to the Gulf Coast.

The ride will be four days long starting in Daytona Beach on Nov. 26. The tentative route goes through Deland, Sanford, Mt. Dora, Howey-in-the-Hills and Brooksville ending at Bayport on the Gulf Coast. The total distance for the ride will be about 160 miles.

If you are in the area, Kathleen and her husband would love to meet you for breakfast, lunch or dinner at any of the points along the way. Or if you want to ride part of the way with them, even for a few miles, they'd love that, too, Please contact them so they can let you know where they will be at various times along the route.
