Of these, 96 were excluded from all calculations in the table, except those for Terrorism, Use of a Minor, Reckless Endangerment, and Acceptance of Responsibility, due to missing Chapter Three adjustment information. Excluded cases for the other Chapter Three adjustments were: Terrorism (319), Use of a Minor (28), Reckless Endangerment (28), and Acceptance of Responsibility (87). Descriptions of each guideline adjustment can be found in USSG Chapter Three.
