GovBenefits.gov was launched in April 2002, as part of President George Bush's E-Government strategy to make it easier for citizens and businesses to interact with their government. GovBenefits.gov consolidates information about hundreds of government benefit and assistance programs, including federal and state programs, previously spread across 31 million web pages. New programs are regularly added to the site.
