¹Of the 59,846 cases, 23,542 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 23,424 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these 23,424 cases, 164 were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing information on offender's citizenship (118) or missing information on drug type (48). Descriptions of variables used in this table are provided in Appendix A.
