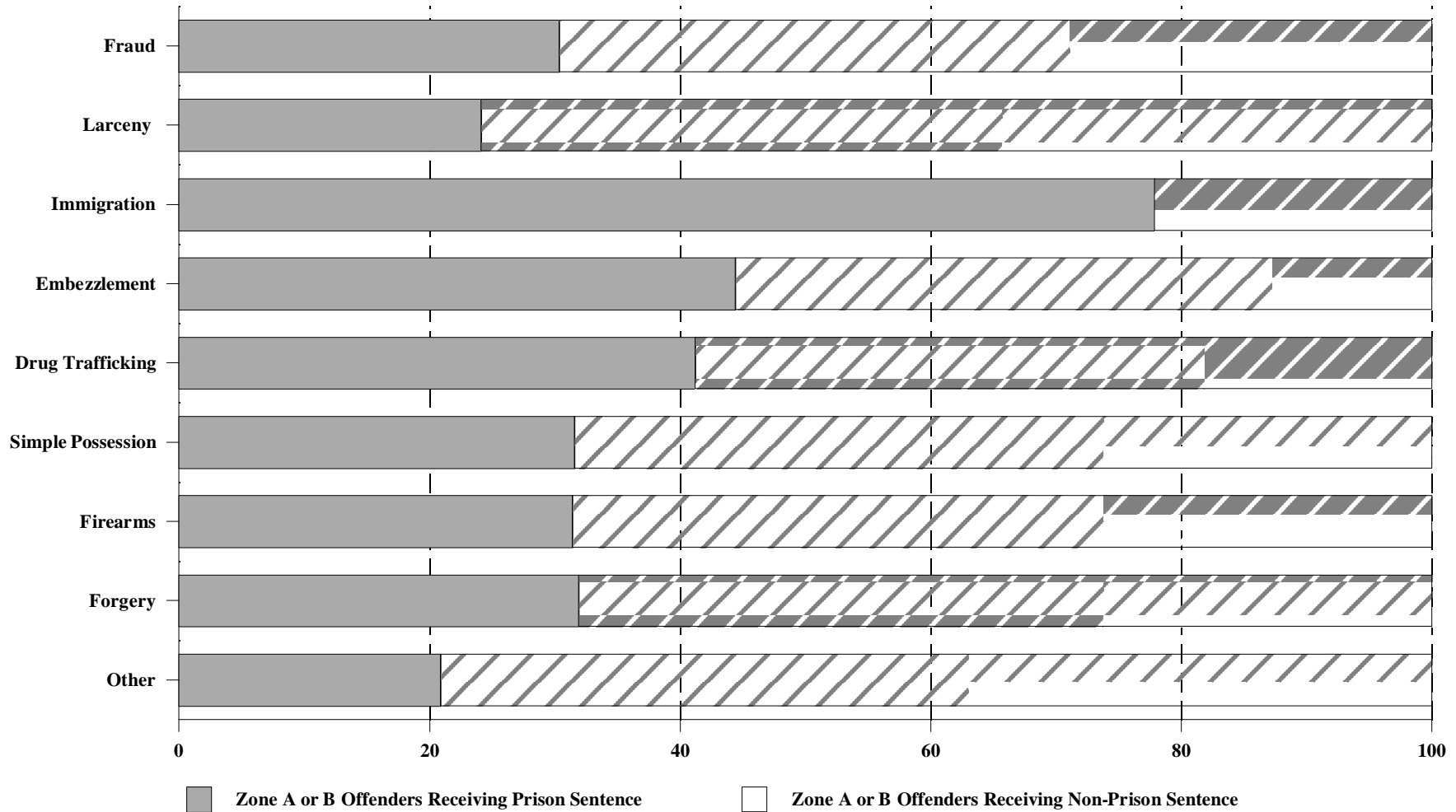

¹ Of the 48,848 cases, the Commission received complete guideline application information for 41,737 cases. Of these 41,737 cases, 8,824 were eligible for non-prison sentences because their guideline sentence ranges were in zones A or B. In addition, seven cases were excluded due to missing information on offense type. Prison sentences include either prison alone or prison with conditions of alternative confinement as defined in USSG §5C1.1. Non-prison sentences include either probation alone or probation with conditions of confinement. Descriptions of variables used in this figure are provided in Appendix A.
