### *Tucson leads way on EPA list*

More than 10 percent of commuters in metropolitan Tucson work for employers on the Environmental Protection Agency's list of Best Workplaces for Commuters, the highest percentage of any metro area in the country.

Earlier this month, the EPA and the Pima Association of Governments unveiled the 2004 list of Tucson's Best Workplaces for Commuters.

Tucson employers on the list are Abrams Airborne Manufacturing, Devon Gables Health Care Center, the Tucson Hilton East, the Tucson El Conquistador Golf & Tennis Resort, IBM, Loews Ventana Canyon Resort and National Bank of Arizona.

Others on the list are Raytheon Missile Systems, Sun Tran, The Westin La Paloma Resort & Spa, Tucson Downtown Alliance, Tucson Electric Power Co., University Medical Center, Ventana Medical Systems and the Viscount Suite Hotel.

A number of government entities made the list as well, including: the city of Tucson, Pima County, UA, the town of Marana and the Tucson Airport Authority.

Employers on the list encourage workers to walk, ride a bike, take the bus, carpool and work from home on certain days.
