REVISED PROPOSED AMENDMENT: ECSTASY

Synopsis of Proposed Amendment: This proposed amendment addresses the directive in the Ecstasy Anti-Proliferation Act of 2000 (the "Act"), section 3664 of Pub. L. 106–310, which instructs the Commission to provide, under emergency amendment authority, increased penalties for the manufacture, importation, exportation, or trafficking of Ecstasy. The directive specifically requires the Commission to increase the base offense level for 3,4-methylenedioxy methamphetamine (MDMA), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine (MDA), 3,4-methylenedioxy-N-ethylamphetamine (MDEA), paramethoxymethamphetamine (PMA), and any other controlled substance that is marketed as Ecstasy and that has either a chemical structure similar to MDMA.

The proposed amendment addresses the directive by amending the Drug Equivalency Table in §2D1.1, Application Note 10, to increase the marihuana equivalencies for the specified controlled substances.
