

¹Ofthe 50,754 cases, the Commission received complete guide line application information for 44,065 cases. Of these 44,065 cases, 8,275 were eligible for non-prison sentences because their guide line sentenceranges were in zones A or B. In addition, nine cases were excluded due to missing information on offense type. Prison sentences include either prison alone or prison with conditions of altermative confinement as defined in USSG \$5C1.1. Non-prison sentences include either probation alone or probation with conditions of confinement. Descriptions of variables used in this figure are provided in Appendix A.
