Of the 59,897 cases, 24,492 were sentenced under USSG Chapter Two, Part D (Drugs). Of these, 24,349 were sentenced under §§2D1.1 (Drug Trafficking), 2D1.2 (Protected Locations), 2D1.5 (Continuing Criminal Enterprise), 2D1.6 (Communication Facility), 2D1.8 (Rent/Manage Drug Establishment), or 2D2.1 (Simple Possession). Of these, 22,594 contained complete guideline application information. Of these 22,594 cases, 46 were excluded due to one or both of the following reasons: missing drug type (42) or missing acceptance of responsibility information (4).
