Breakout Sessions

USGS-128 Purgewater Discharge – Sampling of the affected soils is to be completed by the end of October. Once the data is validated, a letter report will be submitted to DEQ requesting a NLCI, if supported by the data.

VCO topics – Minutes/actions from this session will be handled under the normal VCO process

ILTSF/ANL-E Discussion – NE-ID, DOE-CH, DEQ, and BBWI representatives met to discuss the efforts to date and results from the previously identified waste characterization issue at the ILTSF. The DEQ was presented with information on the RH-TRU to WIPP project, which is a subset of the larger Idaho Completion Project. The specifics of the project schedule and deliverables were highlighted. As part of the presentation, discussion on the ANL-E waste characterization issue was presented. Namely, NE-ID and DOE-CH described the issues surrounding the ANL-E waste characterization issue that surfaced from the collection of acceptable knowledge for the ANL-E RH-TRU waste in storage at the ILTSF. The issue was in regard to the potential use of RCRA regulated constituents within the ANL-E hot cell that generated the ANL-E RH-TRU wastes. NE-ID and DOE-CH described the process that was used to bring the issue to resolution. The efforts to identify additional documentation and/or provide technical justification to close out remaining issues did not conclusively demonstrate that hazardous constituents currently exist in the ANL-E RH-TRU waste. Based on that, NE-ID stated that the INEEL will continue to manage the ANL-E RH-TRU waste consistent with its current characterization of non-hazardous RH-TRU waste.
