## Important News About E-Orders and Adobe 6.0!!!

## The Problem:

Our E-Orders program utilizing Appligent software has experienced some problems with PDF formatting on Orders Upload. Below is a list of problems we have found along with the corrective steps to repair those issues.

E-Order: Proposed Order Formatting / Requirements.

To view Document Fonts, type CTRL/ALT/F \*\*You must click List All Fonts... to see Embedded fonts.

- You can only upload files with a .pdf extension.
- 2. If you use Adobe Acrobat Writer version 3 or 4 to convert orders to pdf, your orders should be prepared using the Courier, Helvetica, or Times New Roman font (regular, bold, italic, and bold italic). If you use Adobe Acrobat Writer version 5 or greater, your orders should be prepared using the Arial, Courier, or Times New Roman font (regular, bold, italic, and bold italic). Other fonts will not process correctly through the court's noticing center.
- 3. Your page size (and orientation) should be 8.5 X 11, portrait (note that this is not the same as 11 X 8.5 landscape)

To view Document Summary, type CTRL/D

- 4. Security must be turned off on pdf.
- 5. E-Orders can not stamp documents which have been created with Adobe Distiller 6.0 default settings. See the steps below to adjust the particular parameters to make Adobe Distiller 6.0 produce a 'signable' PDF file:

In Adobe Distiller 6.0

Click Settings
Click Edit Adobe PDF Settings
{A new screen appears}
Click File Options
{There will be a line called: Object
Level Compression. It will have a
drop down menu. There will be two
choices Off and Tags Only}
CHOOSE OFF

- 6. A four inch space must be present at the top of the first page of the order. E-Orders will sign the order; however, it will be illegible atop the existing text of the order.
- 7. Page orientation must be vertical. PLEASE FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES!!!
