Pursuant to the authorization and direction contained in an Act entitled "An Act For the prevention and removal of obstructions and burdens upon interstate commerce in grain, by regulating transactions on grain future exchanges, and for other purposes", Public No. 331, 67th Congress, known by the short title of "The Grain Futures Act", I, C. F. Marvin, Acting Secretary of Agriculture, hereby designate the Grain Trade Association of the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce, San Francisco, California, as a "Contract Market" for barley under said Act, said Grain Trade Association having applied for, and having otherwise complied with the conditions and requirements of said Act as a prerequisite to, such designation. Such designation is subject hereafter to suspension or revocation in accordance with the provisions of said Act.
