# ORDER PURSUANT TO DELEGATED AUTHORITY

Complainant Ya-Feng Wang ("Wang") filed a timely notice of appeal from the Judgment Officer's initial decision dismissing his complaint. To perfect his appeal, complainant was required to file and serve an appeal brief by August 2, 2004. *See* Commission Regulation 12.401(b). On July 31, 2004, complainant filed and served a motion asking the Commission to extend his filing deadline for six months, until February 2, 2005. In support of his motion, complainant asserts his pro se status, his "very busy work schedule," Motion for Extension at 1, and problems with his computer.

The requested extension is excessive. Complainant shall file and serve his brief on or before October 1, 2004. Complainant is granted leave to file an informal document in lieu of a brief, if he wishes. *See* Commission Regulation 12.401(d).
