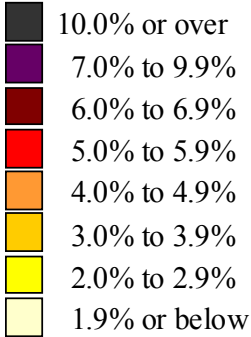
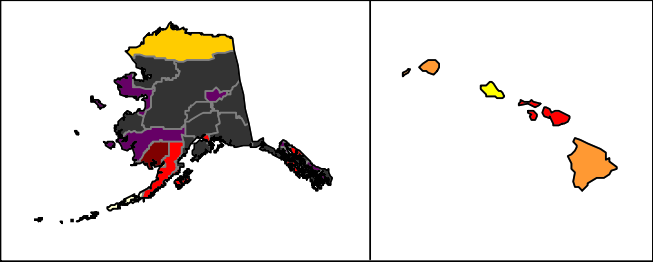
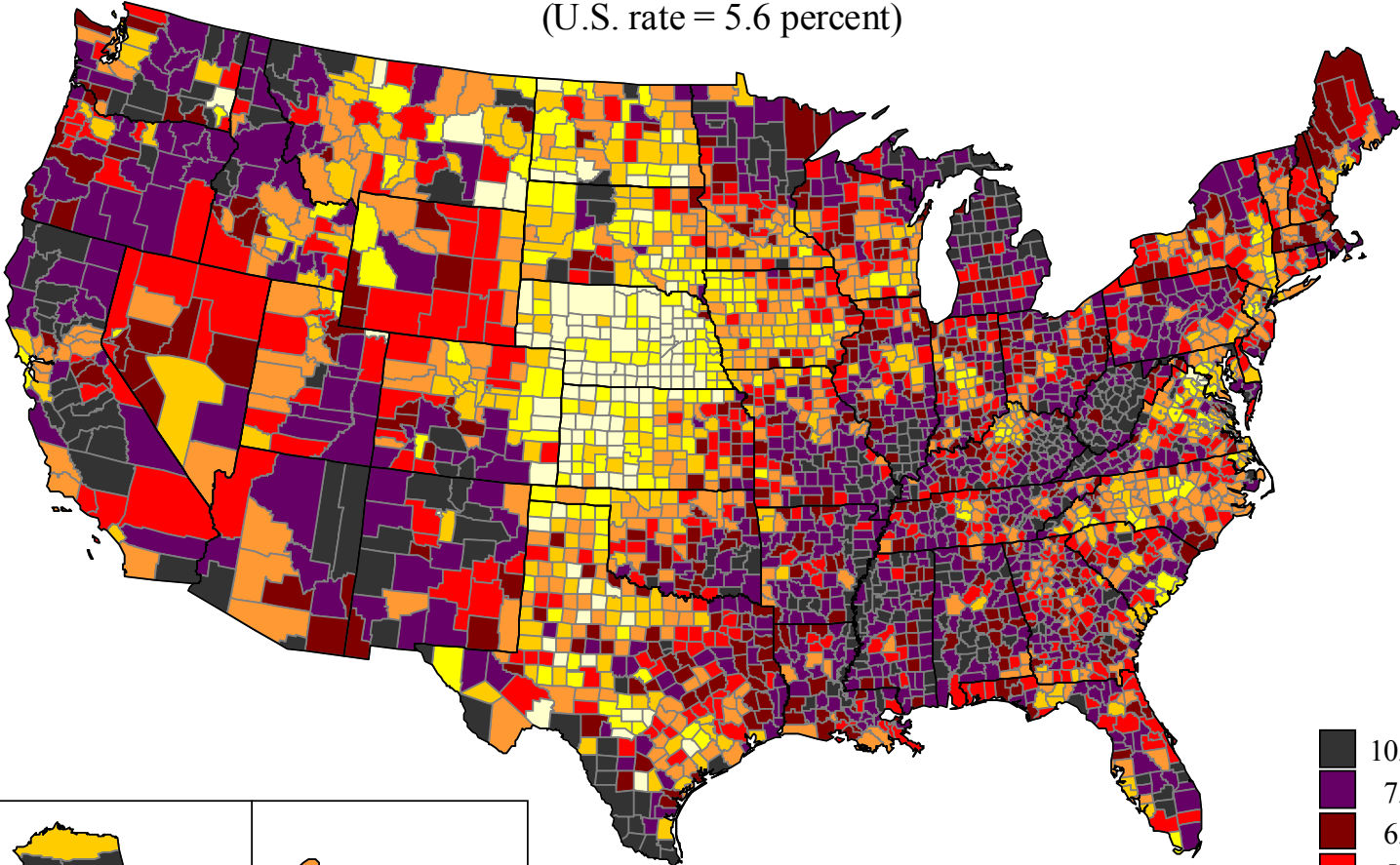


Unemployment rates by county, 1990 annual averages

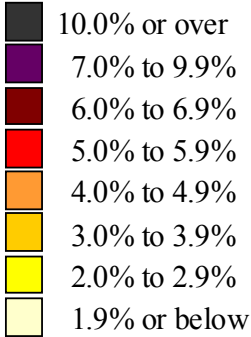
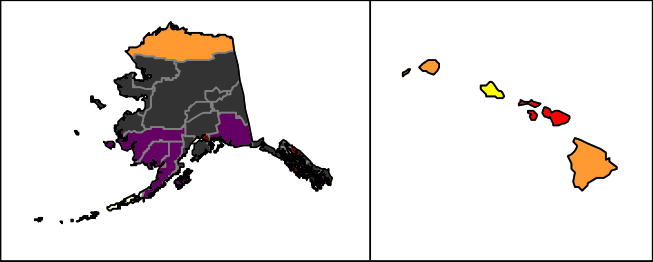
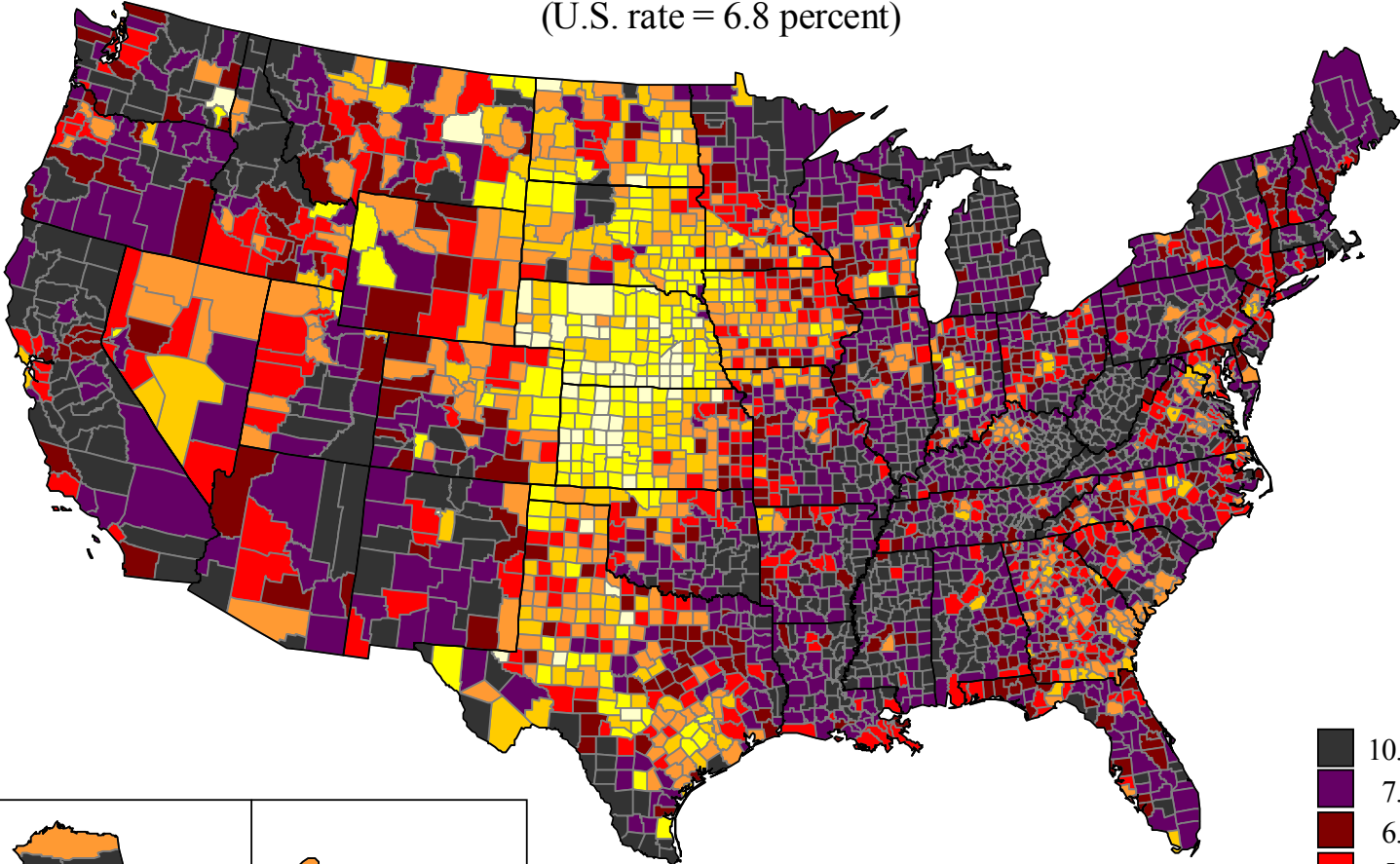

Unemployment rates by county, 1991 annual averages

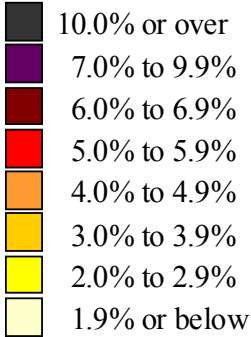
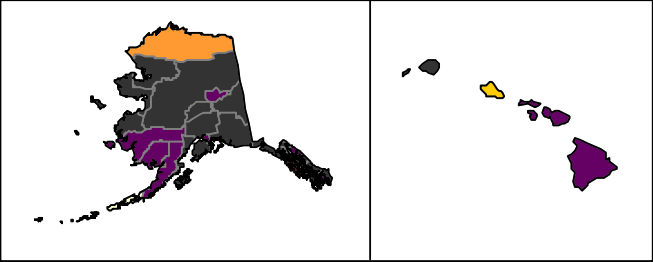
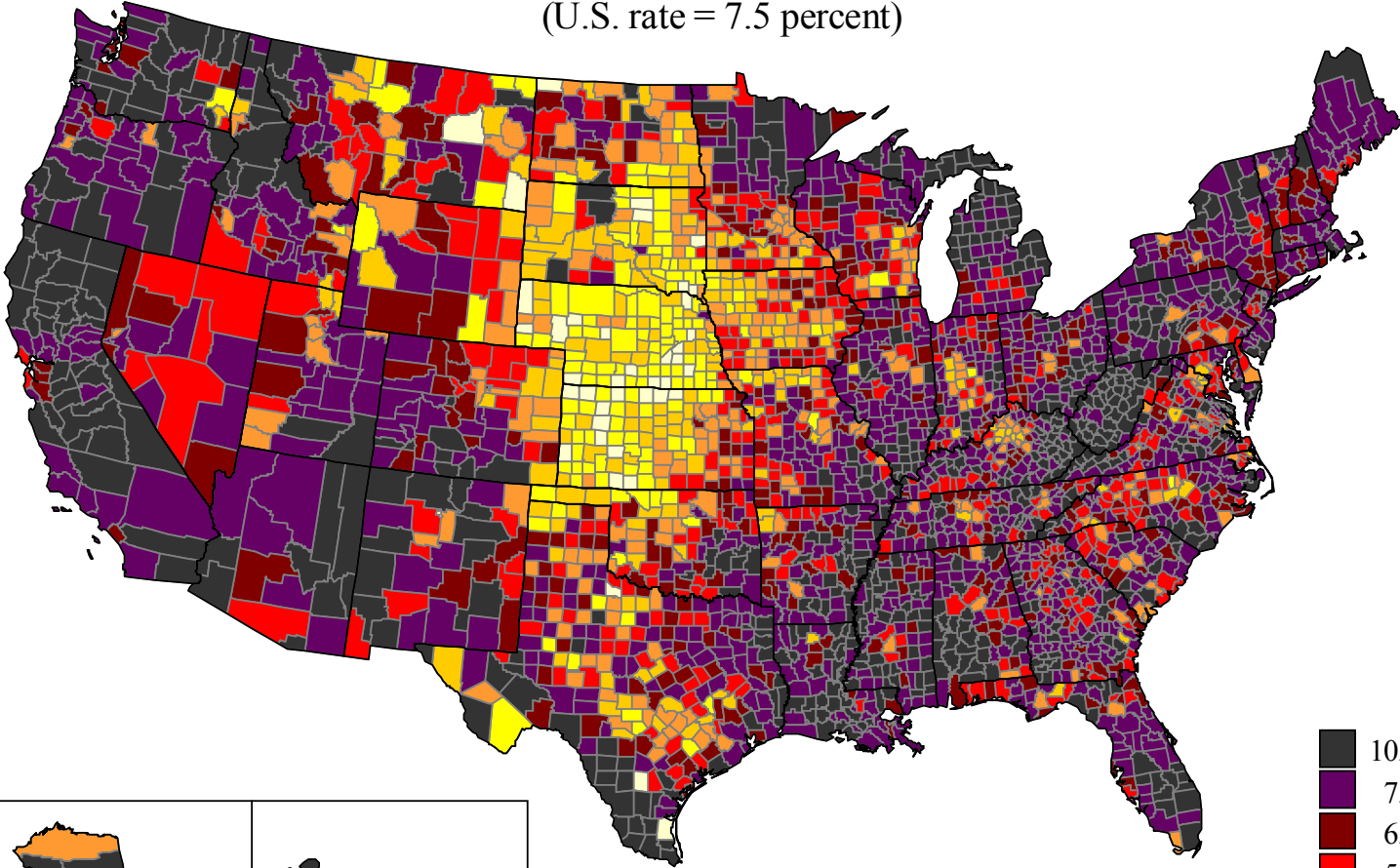

Unemployment rates by county, 1992 annual averages

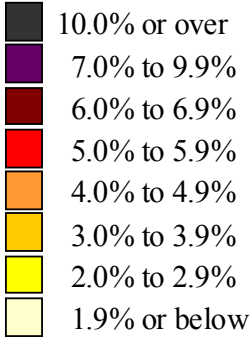
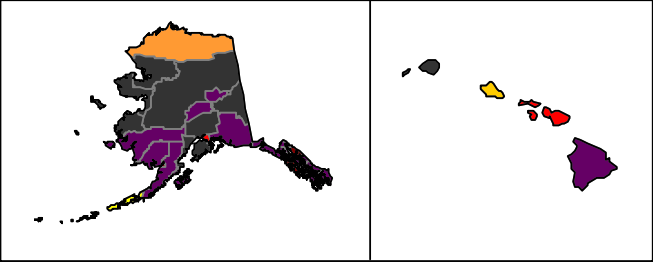
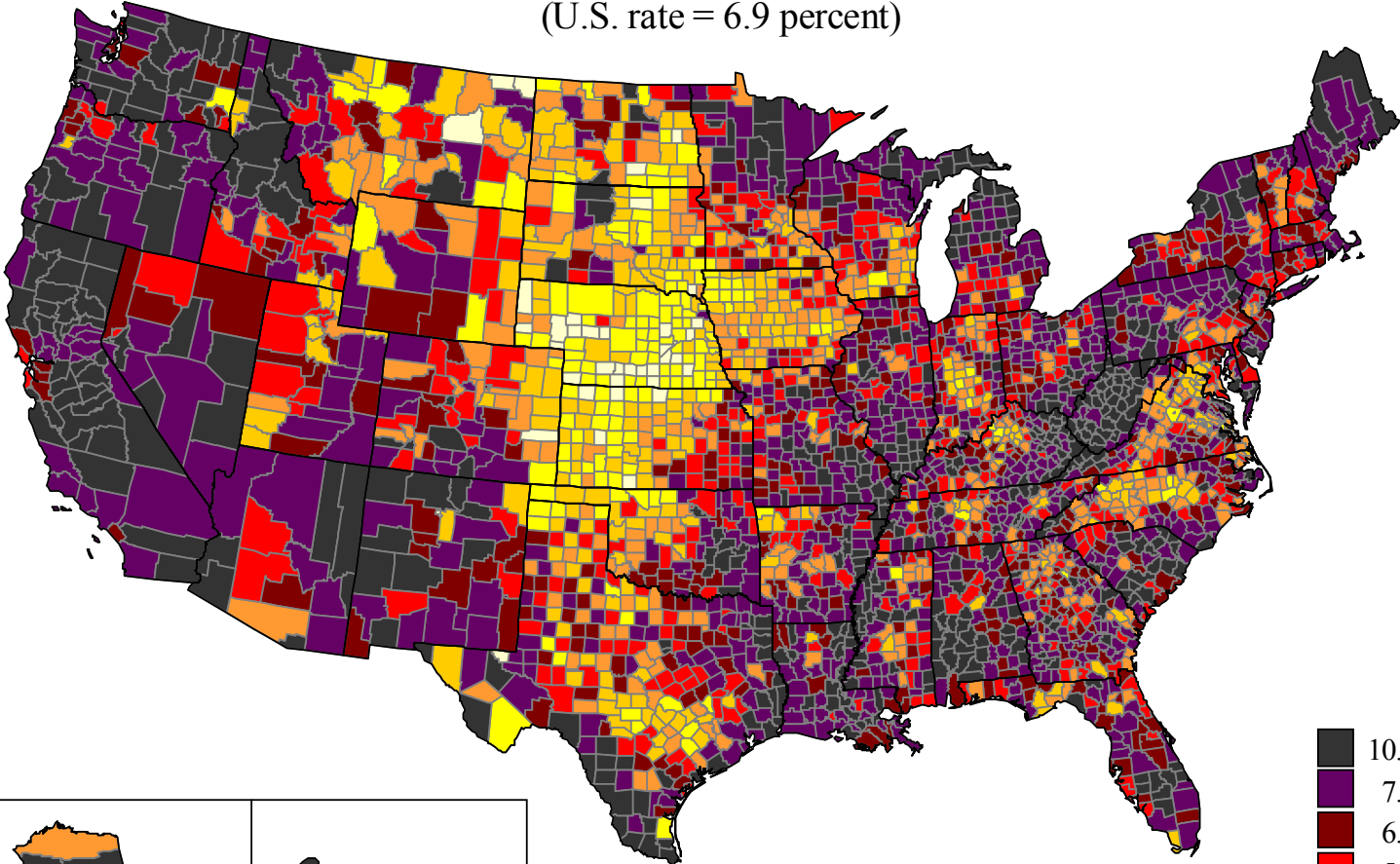

Unemployment rates by county, 1993 annual averages

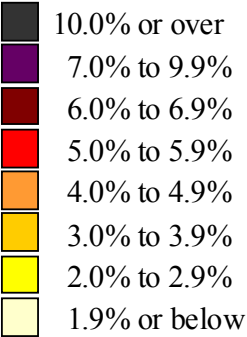
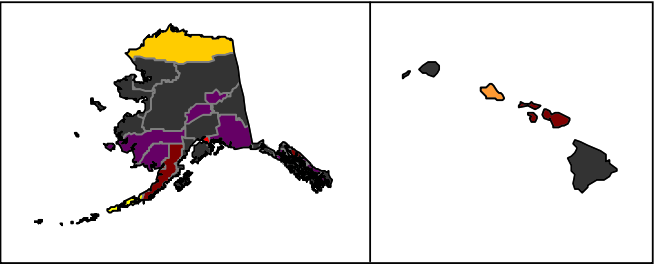
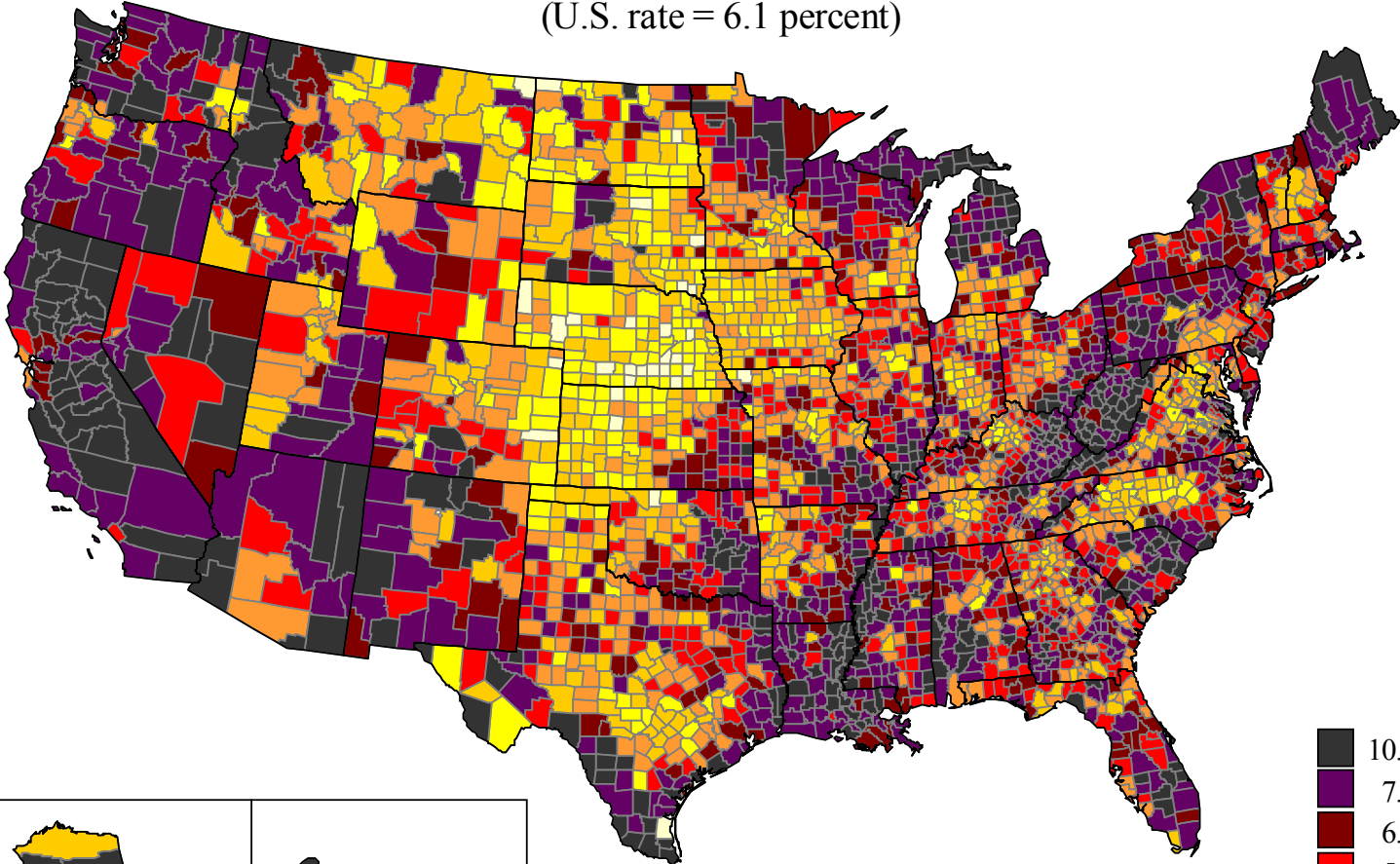

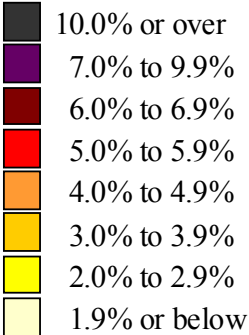

Unemployment rates by county, 1996 annual averages

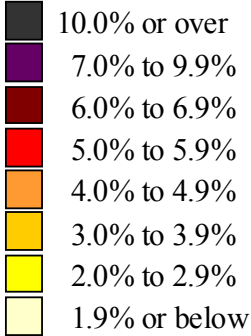
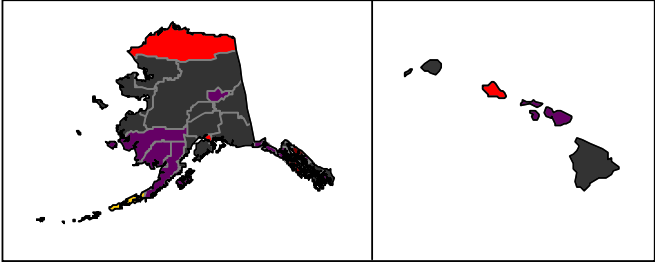
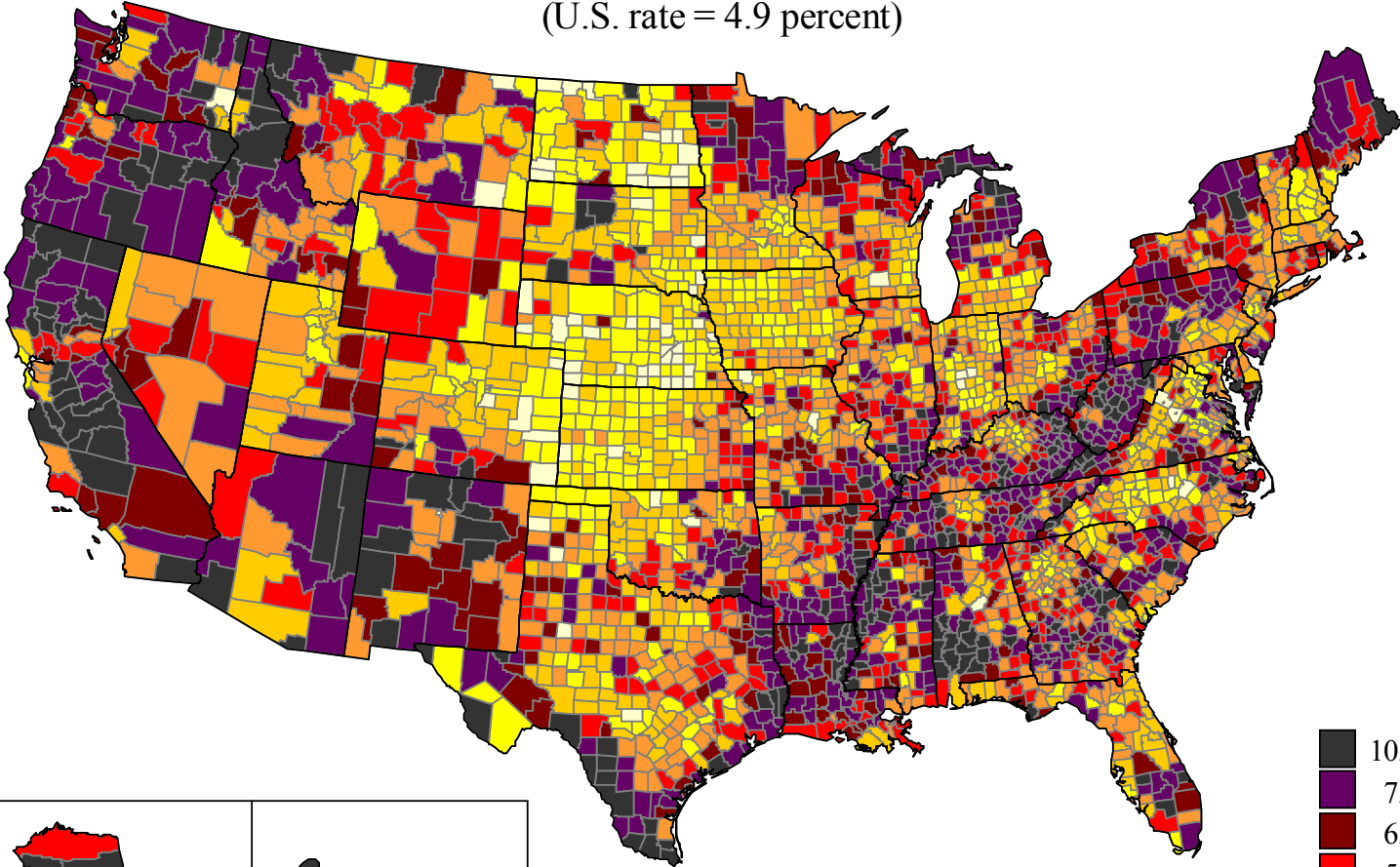

Unemployment rates by county, 1997 annual averages

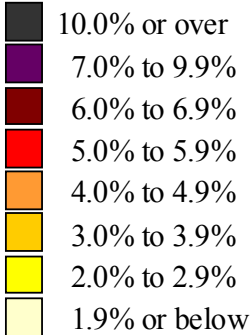
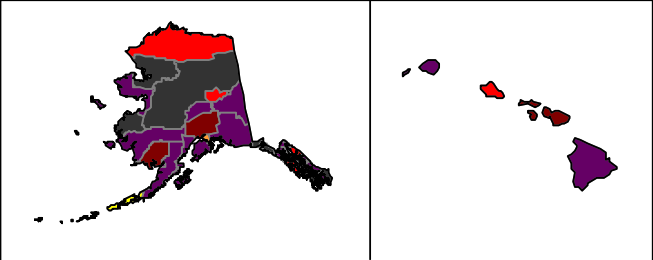
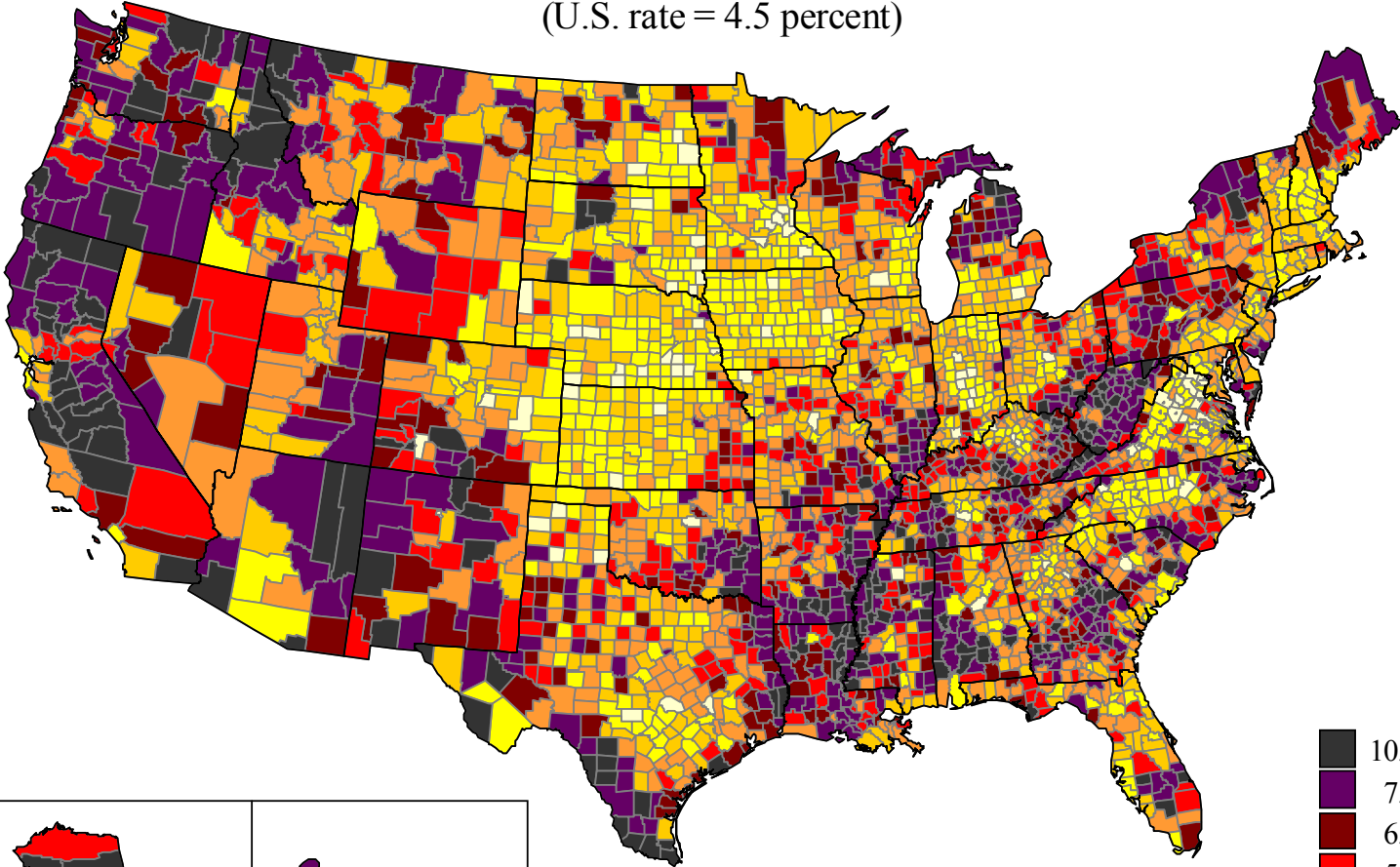

Unemployment rates by county, 1998 annual averages

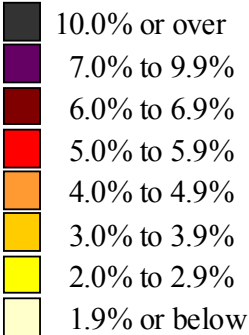
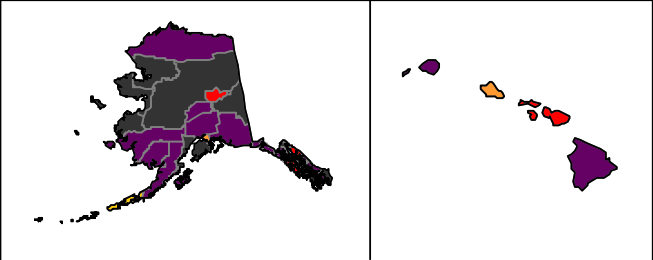
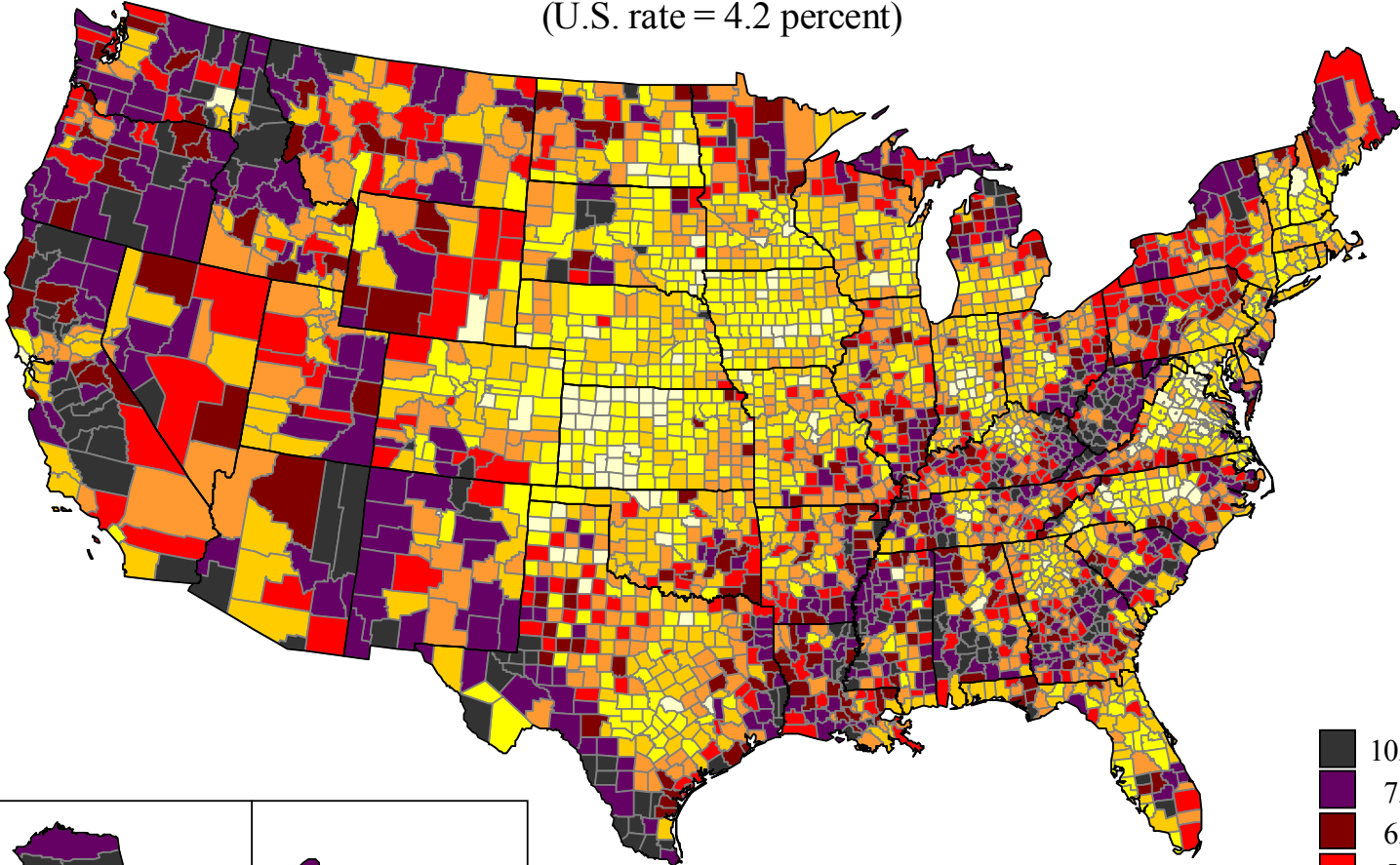

Unemployment rates by county, 1999 annual averages

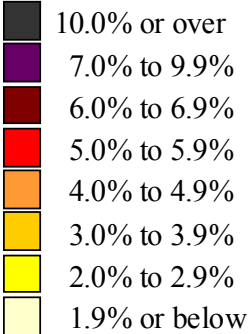
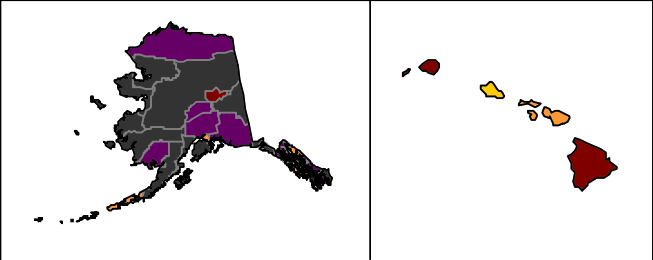
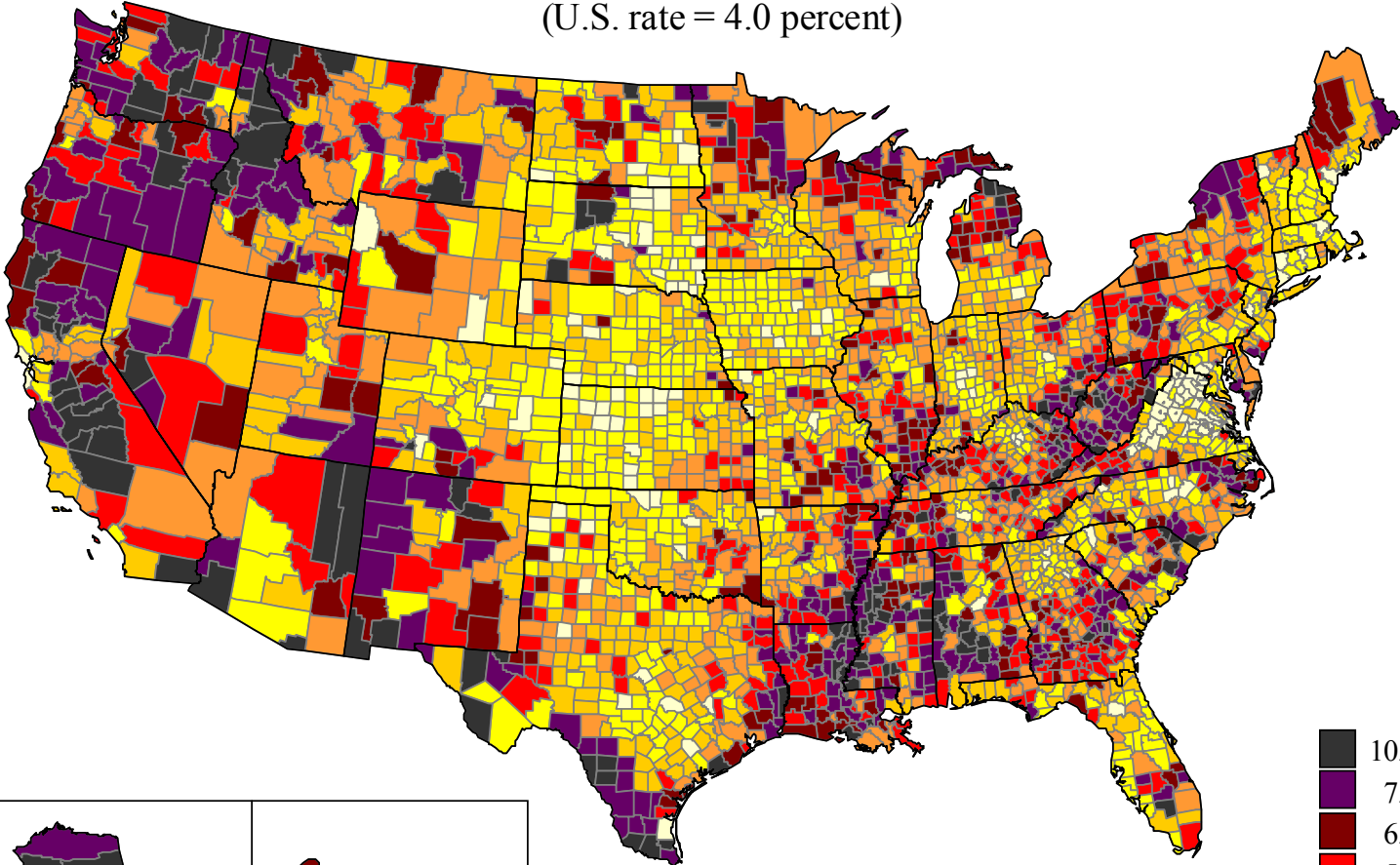

Unemployment rates by county, 2000 annual averages

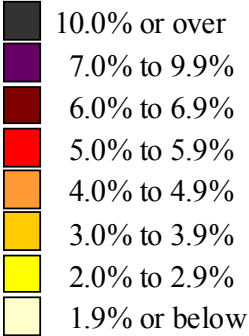
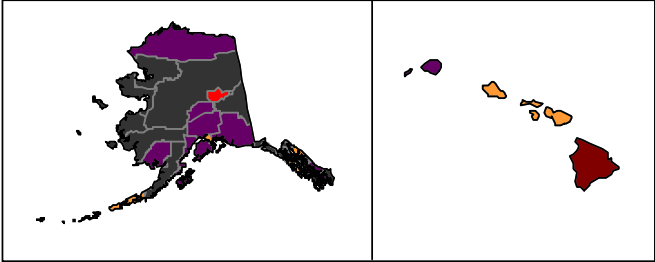
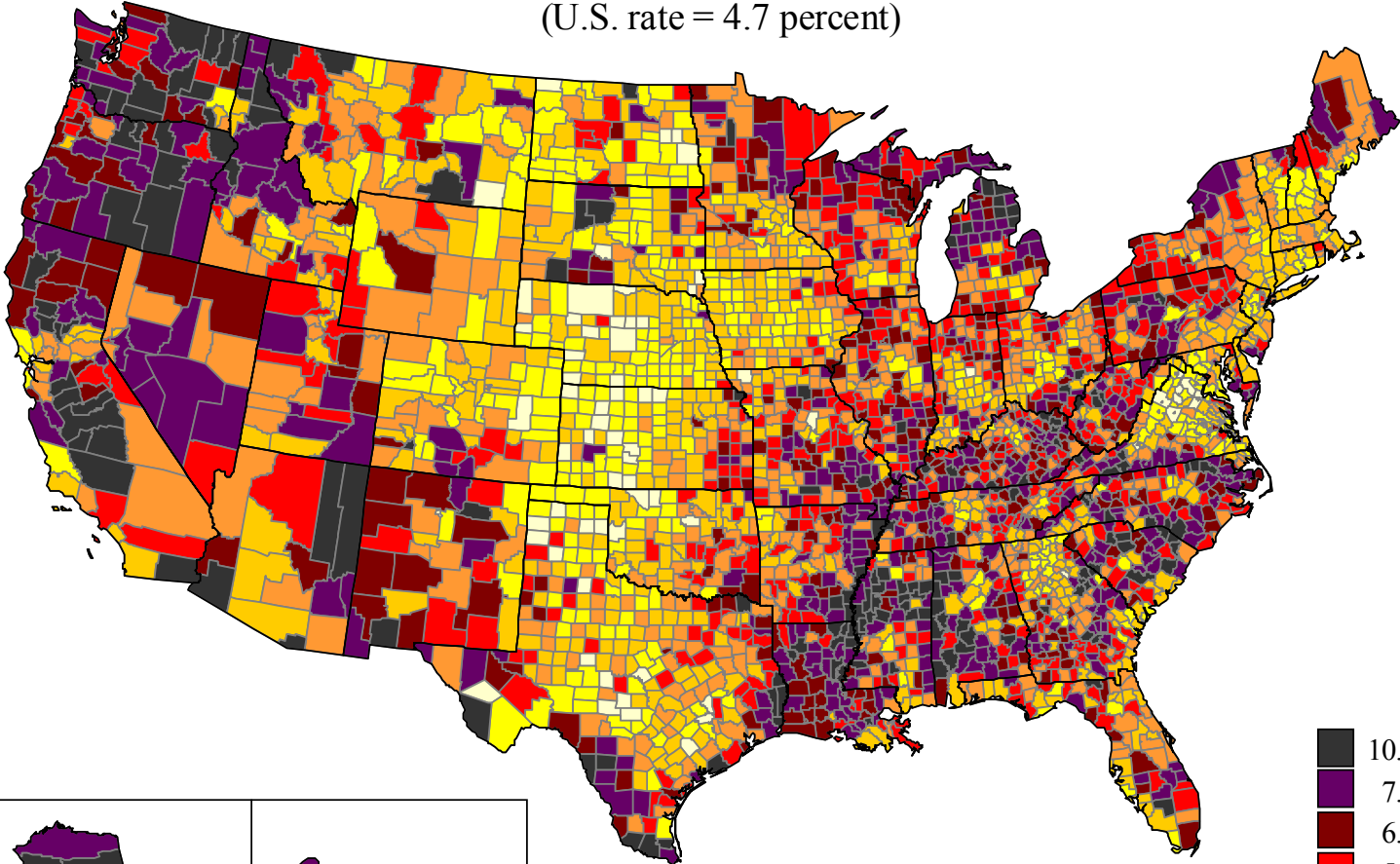

Unemployment rates by county, 2001 annual averages

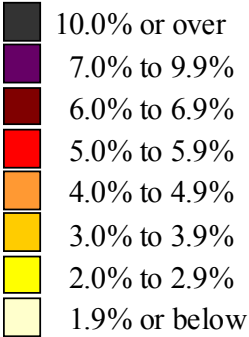
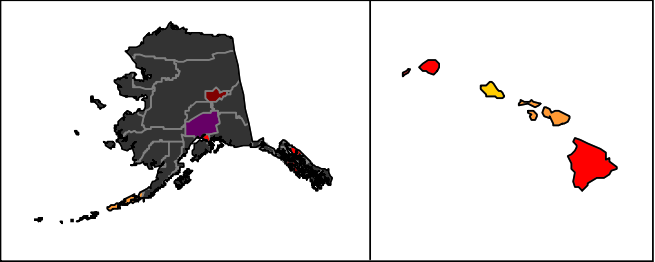
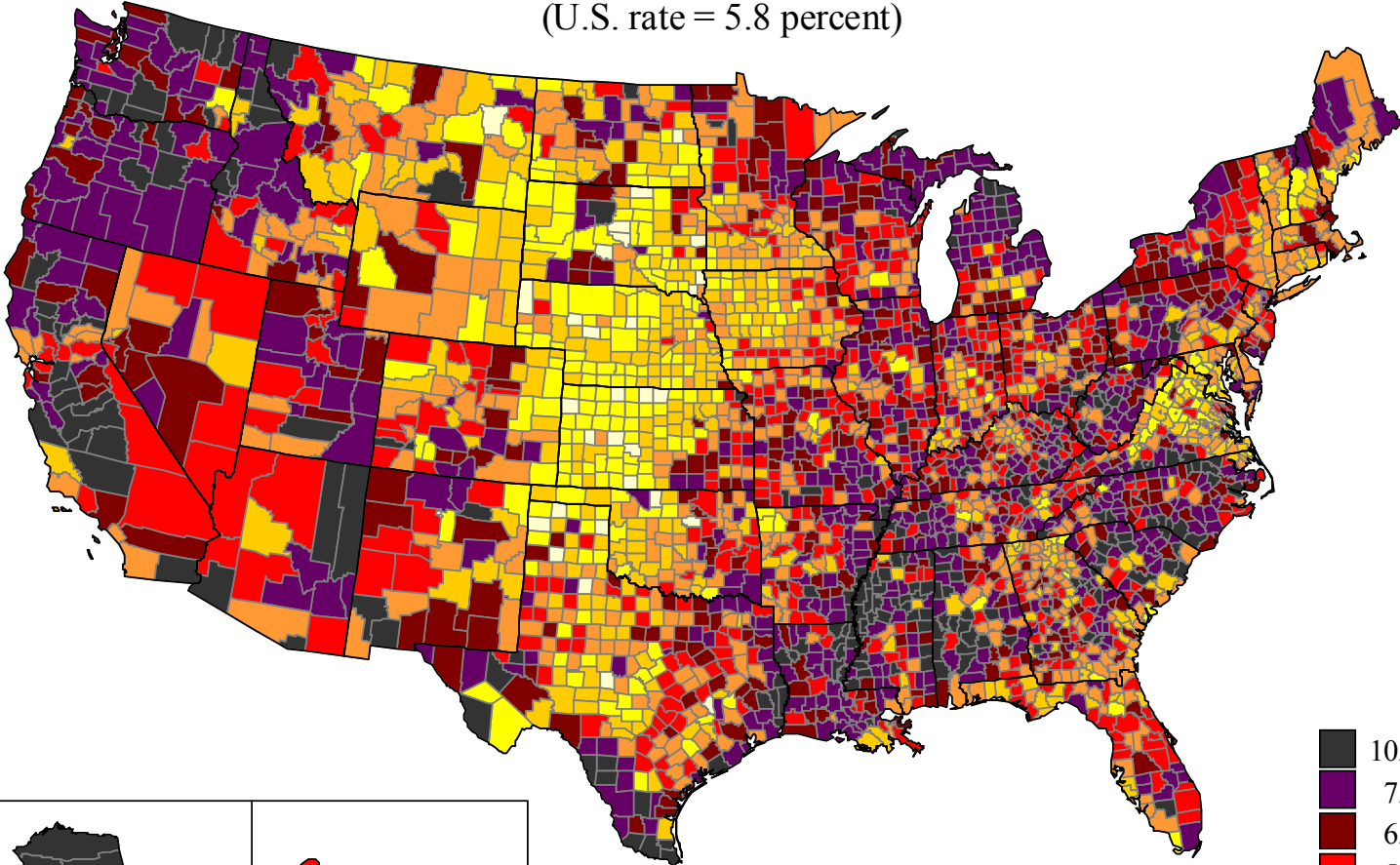

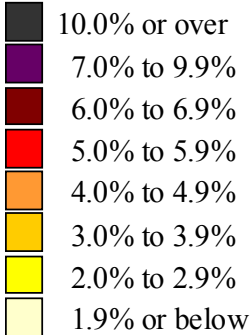
