## U.S. MARINE CORPS VOTING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM BEST PRACTICES

- 1. The following is a list of some of the best practices provided by Marine Corps Bases and Stations used to heighten the awareness of the voting program within the Corps.
  - a. Disseminated voting information via electronic mail.
- b. Disseminated voting information and voting articles via base newspapers and command bulletin boards.
- c. VAO's have been added to the check in/check out sheet for Marines arriving at and leaving duty stations.
- d. Set up voting awareness stations outside of MCCS facilities (gym, exchange, commissary, etc).
  - e. Conducted voting training during Marine Battle Skills Training (MBST).
- f. The "Absentee Voting" video was aired on base television stations. The Armed Forces Network (AFN) radio and television was utilized to distribute information regarding voting.
- g. Utilized the Key Volunteer Network (KVN) to pass voting information to family members.
