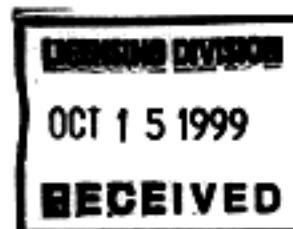


Initial Notice of Digital Transmissions of Sound Recordings Under Statutory License
