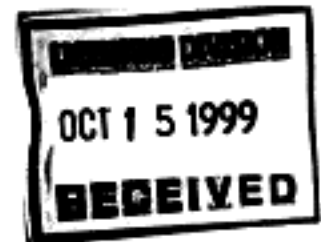


**Initial Notice of Digital Transmissions of Sound Recordings
