"Our position is clear, Diploma Mills may not be used to qualify for Federal jobs or salaries; you may not send employees to Diploma Mills for degree training or for any other form of education; you may not reimburse employees for tuition associated with these schools; and you may not use your authority to repay student loans if the degree is from a Diploma Mill."

## **Categories of Higher Education**

- Conventional/Accredited
- Non-Accredited/Pending Accreditation
- Non-Accredited/Other
- Non-Qualifying



## **Activities**

- Student Loan Repayment
- Academic Degree Training Program
- Tuition Reimbursement or Employee Training
- Position Qualification Requirements [including Student Educational Employment Programs (SEEP)]



## Conventional/Accredited

- Degree-granting schools that are accredited by accrediting institutions recognized by the U.S.
   Department of Education (DoED)
- Can be considered for all activities:
  - Student Loan Repayment
  - Academic Degree Training Program
  - Tuition Reimbursement/Employee Training
  - Position Qualification Requirements, including
     SEEP



## Non-Accredited/Pending Accreditation

- Not accredited by an accrediting institution recognized by DoED, but offer a curriculum for advanced learning AND are in the process of seeking accreditation or have received "preaccreditation" and "candidate for accreditation" status
- Can be considered for:
  - Tuition Reimbursement or Employee Training
  - Position Qualification Requirements (but not SEEP)



## Non-Accredited/Other

- Schools with traditional curriculums but chose not to seek accreditation
- Foreign institutions with comparable courses of study
- Cannot evaluate these programs



## Non-Accredited/Other (continued)

- Only used for:
  - Tuition Reimbursement or Employee
    Training with caveat that supervisor must
    determine that the program meets the
    training needs of the individual and the
    agency before approving training



## **Non-Qualifying**

- Non-traditional schools that are not accredited by institutions recognized by DoED and may be awarded degrees or certificates with little or no course work
- Degrees based largely on life experience or cash payments



## **Non-Qualifying (continued)**

- Includes Diploma Mills and organizations that sell counterfeit degrees
- There is no place in Federal employment for "degrees" from these institutions qualifications, training, tuition reimbursement

## **Definition**

## Diploma Mills

are not accredited by an appropriate authority subject to oversight by the Secretary, U.S. Department of Education and generally involve payment of a fee in exchange for a degree, without any significant academic requirements.



## **Evolution of Diploma Mills**

- 1980s unsophisticated, tabloid ads
- 1990s free school video, 800 numbers, accepting credit cards, "virtual tour" on Internet

### 2000-present

- "Accreditation" highlighted in advertisements
- ".edu" in school's web address
- United Kingdom and British Commonwealths are bases of world-wide Diploma Mill operations
- Accreditation by Liberia, but located elsewhere



## **Degree Replacement Services**

- Replace a "lost" diploma or certificate
- No proof of degree or attendance required to obtain replacement
- Examples:

  - www.diplomaville.com
  - www.diplomaservices.com

## **Diploma Mills**

- Causes damage by misunderstanding
- Devalues earned degrees (look-a-likes and sound-a-likes)
- Confuses the public
- Defrauds "students"
- Deceives employers, customers, clients, patients, etc.
- Lowers prestige abroad



## WARNING

"Education" from Diploma Mills <u>cannot</u> be considered for:

- Student Loan Repayment
- Academic Degree Training Program
- Tuition Reimbursement or EmployeeTraining
- Position Qualification Requirements



## How Do I Detect a Diploma Mill?



## **Red Flags**

- No High School diploma or GED, but application shows advanced degree
- No undergraduate degree claimed, but applicant shows graduate or doctorate degree
- Graduate or doctorate received before the lower degree
- Multiple degrees received in same year
- Unfamiliar school name



## **Additional Red Flags**

- Same or similar name to legitimate school, but located in a different state
- Application/Resume shows full time employment during period of college attendance, particularly if college and employment were in different locations
- Education claims are different on application resume
- Red Flags see attachments



## **Verifying Education**

- Use <u>credible</u> sources to verify degrees and accrediting institutions
  - Internet Sources
    - <u>www.ed.gov-</u> U.S. Department of Education
    - <u>www.opm.gov/qualifications</u> reference section
    - <a href="http://www.chea.org">http://www.chea.org</a> Council for Higher Education Accreditation

## **Agency Education Verification**

- Research the Internet
- Attempt to contact school
- Request a Reimbursable Suitability Investigation (RSI) from OPM
- Ask the individual for proof of the degree and the school's accreditation



## **OPM Education Verification**

- OPM verifies the most recent or highest degree claimed in BI and NACI products.
- If degree is not verified or is a suspected diploma mill:
  - characterized as an 05D.
  - Referred internally to SAB for suitability review and possible adjudication.
- OPM coordinates the adjudication with the agency.



# How does OPM or the agency adjudicate fraudulent degree claims?



## **Competitive Service**

• 5 CFR 731.202(b)(2), Criminal or dishonest conduct

• 5 CFR 731.202(b)(3), Material, intentional false statement or deception or fraud in examination or appointment



## **Competitive Service (continued)**

When does OPM use 5 CFR 731(b)(3) Material, intentional false statement or deception or fraud in examination or appointment?

- Application or appointment forms
- Interviews/examinations
- Investigative data forms
- Personnel Subject Interview (PRSI)



## **Material and Intentional**

• To be disqualifying under 5 CFR 731, the false statement must be both material **and** intentional.

• A "material" statement is one that is "capable of influencing, or has a natural tendency to affect, an official decision."



## **Material and Intentional (continued)**

- "Official decisions" include determining whether an individual:
  - Meets the qualifications requirements for the position
  - Is eligible for a special hiring program
     (Outstanding Scholar) or appointment at a higher grade level
  - Is a better candidate over other qualified candidates
  - Is hired over other applicants



## **Material and Intentional (continued)**

• To prove "intent" need to determine if the individual knew the school was a Diploma Mill.

- "I didn't know it was a Diploma Mill."
  - "Reasonable person" approach
  - Red Flags



## **Competitive Service**

When does OPM or the agency use 5 CFR 731.202(b)(2), Criminal or dishonest conduct?

- Falsification is intentional but not material to the position.
- Appointment not subject to investigation:
  - promotions, reinvestigations, excepted service, etc.
- Non-Federal job applications contractors, NAF positions, private sector employment, etc.



## **Excepted Service**

The following reasons may disqualify an individual:

• 5 CFR 302.203(a)(2), Criminal, infamous, dishonest, immoral, or notoriously disgraceful conduct.

• 5 CFR 302.203(a)(3), Intentional false statement or deception or fraud in examination or appointment.



## **Security**

### Security clearance criteria

E.O. 12968, Guideline E, Personal Conduct:

- Deliberate omission, concealment, or falsification of relevant and material facts from any personnel security questionnaires, etc.
- Deliberately providing false or misleading information concerning relevant and material matters to an investigator, etc.



## **Suitability Referrals**

Examining or agency personnel offices should refer applications for competitive service positions to OPM–SAB for adjudication involving:

- Material, intentional false statement or deception or fraud in examination or appointment
  - Example: Applicant claims education from a known diploma mill school or claims education he did not obtain.

## **OPM Actions**

• OPM-SAB can take the following suitability actions:

- Debar for period up to 3 years
- Direct removal
- Cancel pending applications or eligibilities



## **Agency Actions**

- The appropriate corrective action depends on whether the individual intentionally falsified the form and is qualified for the position.
- Actions range from not hiring, reassignment, change to lower grade, or removal.
- OPM recommends not hiring or removal when intentional falsification is established.
- At a minimum, the individual should be told not to claim the degree in the future.



## **Additional Considerations**

- Individuals who knowingly claim a bogus degree gain an unfair advantage over others.
- When the person holds a security clearance or responsible position, should the person continue to hold the clearance or remain employed even if the bogus degree was not material to the initial employment decision?
- Under 18 USC 1001, a false statement on any part of the application may be punished by fine or imprisonment.



## **Merit Systems Principles**

- Federal employees must:
  - "maintain high standards of integrity, conduct, and concern for the public interest."
- Circumventing competitive hiring procedures violates the Merit Systems Principle to:
  - "select and advance only (a) qualified individuals,
    (b) solely on their relative ability, and (c) after fair and open competition that assures equal opportunity."
