- November 8 December 13, 2004
- Significant Events Benefits Administration Letter (BAL) in early October
- Additional BALs as needed
- Guide delivery scheduled October 12, 2004
- Brochure delivery not later than November 8, 2004

Federal Employee's Group Life Insurance (FEGLI) Open Season

FEGLI Open Seasons are rare events

 Current FEGLI Open Season September 1-30, 2004

Last Open Season in 1999



FEGLI 2004 Open Season

Open to all FEGLI eligible employees

Eligible employees can enroll in Basic,
 Option A, Option B, and Option C

No medical questions asked



Delayed Effective Date

- New coverage elected becomes effective the first day of the first pay period that begins on or after September 1, 2005, and that immediately follows a pay period in which the employee meets the pay and duty status requirements.
- No premiums are paid before effective date.



Pay and Duty Status Requirements

 Full-time employees must be in a pay and duty status for at least 32 hours in the pay period before the pay period in which coverage is effective.

 Annual leave, sick leave, donated leave or any other type of leave is NOT pay and duty status.





- Annual Open Season concurrent with FEHB Program Open Season
- November 8 to December 13 for 2005 plan year
- Information in the FEHB brochures



FSAFEDS Eligibility

- You must be eligible for FEHB (not necessarily enrolled in an FEHB plan) to enroll in FSAFEDS
- Your employing agency must participate in the FSAFEDS Program
- Must re-enroll every year

Federal Long Term Care Insurance Program (FLTCIP) Open Season

Infrequent Open Seasons (like FEGLI)

No Plans for an Open Season in 2005



No Need to Wait for an Open Season

- Eligible persons can apply for FLTCIP at any time
- Full underwriting outside of an Open Season
- No physical required

No need to wait for an Open Season if healthy
