



## Partnership for Learning Undergraduate Studies Program PLUS Program Application Form

The PLUS Program is a new initiative of the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational & Cultural Affairs that puts obtaining a U.S. degree within the grasp of outstanding undergraduate students in countries across the Arab world who have previously had little access to such opportunities.

The program selects outstanding students who have already completed two years of undergraduate study at home/regional institutions and provides full scholarships for enhancing their English language and study skills at American institutions before completing an undergraduate degree program and graduating from a U.S. university.

Besides outstanding academic performance and at least intermediate English language ability, viable applicants should come from fields within the liberal arts, humanities and social sciences. The program also targets students from underserved regions and social groups who have demonstrated leadership potential and are highly committed to returning to make a difference in their home countries.

GRANT SUSPENSION/TERMINATION/REVOCATION	
A grant may be revoked, terminated, or suspended.	
Grounds for revocation or termination include, but are not limited to: (1) violation of any law of the United States or the host country; (2) any act likely to give offense to the host country; (3) failure to observe satisfactory academic standards; (4) physical or mental incapacitation; (5) engaging any unauthorized income-producing activity; (6) failure to comply with the grant's terms and conditions; (7) material misrepresentation made by any grantee in the application form or grant document.	
A grant may be suspended if: (1) the grantee ceases to carry out the academic program during the grant period; (2) the grantee leaves the assigned academic institution or the host country without authorization of the supervising agency; (3) conditions in the host country require the departure of grantee for reasons of personal safety or security.
