## Leading Health Indicators...Touch Everyone



Healthy People 2010, a broad-based collaborative effort among government, private, public, and nonprofit organizations, has set national disease prevention and health promotion objectives to be achieved by the end of this decade. The effort has two overarching goals: to increase the quality and years of healthy life and to eliminate health disparities.

Healthy People 2010 features 467 science-based objectives and 10 Leading Health Indicators, which use a smaller set of objectives chosen to track progress toward meeting Healthy People 2010 goals.

The Leading Health Indicators represent the important determinants of health for the full range of issues in the 28 focus areas of *Healthy People 2010*. The chart indicates which indicators are most closely related to each of the 28 focus areas and suggests opportunities for collaboration across focus areas.
