

## National Fire Plan Reducing the Impact of Wildfire in Georgia Milledgeville Mobile Firewise Trailer March 2003



The Georgia Forestry Commission, in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service and Baldwin County

Fire Departments, received a grant from the U.S. Forest Service's National Fire Plan wildland/urban interface fire mitigation program. The grant funded a project in Milledgeville, Georgia.

The Mobile Firewise Trailer/Classroom will be used at schools, businesses, and public gatherings such as fairs and expos.



It is equipped with a generator, displays, a firewise diorama, a computer, and educational materials. The trailer will be pulled with a heavy duty Ford F350 diesel pickup.

A request system has been established and will be coordinated through the Forestry Commission's Milledgeville District Office.

This is a very worthwhile project with the ability to reach thousands of people to present the firewise message.
