- MARAD Directs, OAS Funds Joint Initiative
- Foreign port authority, police and security personnel
- 200+ Trained Each Year
- Caribbean, Central and South America
- Mobile Training Team
  - U.S. Maritime Administration
  - Miami-Dade Police Department
  - U.S. Customs

Maritime Transportation Security Act of 2002 Requirements

#### **Foreign Port Security Training**

- U.S. Congress stipulated MARAD/OAS Inter-American Port Security Training Program as MODEL for International Training
- MARAD to develop, and direct specific courses designed to address identified deficiencies in foreign port surveys conducted by U.S. Coast Guard
- MARAD to participate in planning and other elements of assessments, and direct Foreign Training Program

- Questionnaire to Identify Port Security Condition
- Managed Regionally
- Identify Positive Aspects
- Identify Deficiencies

- Identify Specific Solutions to Deficiencies
- Specify exactly what is needed to IMPROVE
- Identify Costs
- Identify possible funding sources
- Data gathered and analyzed for further TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE & Funding Options
