

Version 2.0/2.1 Conversion Enhancements (10/04/04)

PUBLIC ACCESS - Enhancements were made so that public terminals in the court can now be configured so the public login does not time out, and there is no charge (or receipt displayed) for information accessed by the public. The free look period of accessing documents via e-mail notification has been reduced from 30 to 15 days. However, each e-mail addressee listed in the user's "to these additional addresses" will receive a "free look."

MISCELLANEOUS ENHANCEMENTS

Party and Attorney Information - For civil plaintiffs only, the pro se field is now automatically set or reset according to the presence or absence of an attorney.

Docketing - When default deadlines of less than eleven days are calculated, weekends and federal holidays are now excluded in accordance with F.R.C.P. Rule 6a.

The names of attorneys who have configured their e-mail accounts to receive notice in cases in which they are NOT participants are now listed only on the private NEF. The private NEF can be accessed only by users of type jud and crt through the silver ball hyperlink on the docket report.

Reports

Docket Report - The docket report has been modified primarily to enhance performance with criminal cases. **In addition:**

- As with civil cases, an attorney's address is not repeated if the attorney represents more than one party in a criminal case.
- Alias names now appear directly below party names.
