SUBJECT: Waiver-General Services Administration (GSA)
Utilization Screening for Department of Defense (DoD)
Property

Effective March 6, 1998, I waive the GSA screening requirements prescribed in Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 45.608-1(b), 45.608-4, and 45.608-5(b) for special test equipment without standard components. I also waive the GSA screening requirement at FAR 45.608-4 for DoD property in poor and salvage condition (items reported in the inventory schedule with conditions codes: A3, A6, A9, B3, B6, B9, F3, F6, F9, or HX).

These waivers are approved through March 6, 2000.
