POLI A. MARMOLEJOS

Poli A. Marmolejos is the Director of the Department of Energy's (DOE) Office of Civil Rights and Diversity. As Director of the Office of Civil Rights, Poli serves as principal advisor to Department officials on EEO/civil rights matters, and he is responsible for managing DOE's equal employment opportunity program.

Prior to joining DOE, Poli served as a senior trial attorney in the Civil Rights Division of the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ). Poli joined DOJ in 1981 under the Attorney General's Honor Law Graduate Program. During his tenure at DOJ, Poli served as: Special Assistant and Special Counsel to three Assistant Attorneys General of the Civil Rights Division; the Acting Special Counsel and Deputy Special Counsel of the Office of Special Counsel for Immigration Related Unfair Employment Practices; a prosecutor in the office of the U.S. Attorney for the District of Columbia; and senior trial lawyer in the Voting Section of the Civil Rights Division.

Among other things, Poli is a past President of the District of Columbia Hispanic Bar Association; served three terms as President of the Department of Justice Association of Hispanic Employees, and he currently serves as a mediator with the Federal District Court for the District of Columbia Mediation Program.
