SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

CAZ234 – SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY CENTRAL COAST

Defined on the north and south by the county line; on the west by the coast; on the east by the 2500 foot contour of the back range of the Santa Lucia Range to the 1500 foot contour of the Los Padres National Forest.

CAZ237 – SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY INTERIOR VALLEYS

Defined on the north and east by the county line. The west boundary follows the 2500 foot contour of the back range of the Santa Lucia Range to Cuesta Pass then the 2000 foot contour of the Los Padres National Forest to the 2500 foot contour of the Los Padres National Forest.

CAZ251 – SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY MOUNTAINS

Defined on the west by the 1500 foot contour of the front range of the Los Padres National Forest; on the north by the 2000 foot contour of the Los Padres National Forest; on the east by the 2500 foot contour of the Los Padres National Forest; on the south by the county line.

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

CAZ235 – SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CENTRAL COAST

Defined on the north by the county line; on the west by the coast; on the south by a line from Point Conception to the 1000 foot contour to the Gaviota Pass; on the east by a north-south line from the county line through Garey to highway 101.

CAZ236 – SANTA YNEZ VALLEY

Defined on the north by the county line; on the west by a north-south line from the county line through Garey to highway 101; on the south and east by the 1500 foot contour of the Sierra Madre Mountains.

CAZ238 – CUYAMA VALLEY

Defined on the north and east by the county line; on the west and south by the 3000 foot contour of the Sierra Madre Mountains.

CAZ239 – SANTA BARBARA COUNTY SOUTH COAST

Defined on the west by a line from Point Conception north to the 1000 foot contour; on the east by the 1000 foot contour to Gaviota Pass – by the 1500 foot contour from the Gaviota Pass to the county line; on the east by the county line; on the south by the coast. This zone contains the Gaviota Pass.

CAZ252 – SANTA BARBARA COUNTY MOUNTAINS

Defined on the north and east by the county line; on the south and west by the 1500 foot contour of the Sierra Madre Mountains; on the northeast by the 3000 foot contour of the Sierra Madre Mountains.

VENTURA COUNTY

CAZ240 – VENTURA COUNTY COAST

Defined on the north by the 500 foot contour to Aliso Canyon then directly southeast to the 500 foot contour of the Oak Ridge; on the east by 500 foot contour; on the south and west by the coast.

CAZ244 – VENTURA COUNTY INTERIOR VALLEYS

Defined on the north by 1500 foot contour; on the east by the county line, on the south by the 500 foot contour to Aliso Canyon then directly southeast to the 1000 foot contour of the Oak Ridge to the county line; on the west by the county line.

CAZ245 – VENTURA COUNTY COASTAL VALLEYS

Defined on the north by the 1000 foot contour of the Oak Ridge; on the east by the county line; on the south and west by the 500 foot contour.

CAZ253 – VENTURA COUNTY MOUNTAINS

Defined on the north, east and west by the county line; on the south by the 1500 foot contour.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY

CAZ241 – LOS ANGELES COUNTY COAST INCLUDING DOWNTOWN LOS ANGELES

Defined on the north by the 1500 foot contour; on the east by Interstate 5; on the south and west by the coast. This zone extends along the coastal 500 foot contour to the Ventura County line.

CAZ246 – SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS RECREATIONAL AREA

Defined on the north and east by the 1500 foot contour; on the south by the 500 foot contour; on the west by the county line.

CAZ247 – LOS ANGELES COUNTY VALLEYS

Defined on the west and east by the county line; on the north by the 2000 foot contour; on the south by the 1500 foot contour to Interstate 5 and then along Interstate 5 to the county line.

CAZ254 – LOS ANGELES COUNTY MOUNTAINS EXCLUDING THE SANTA MONICA RANGE

Defined on the west and east by the county line; on the north by the 4500 foot contour; on the south by 2000 foot contour.

CAZ259 – ANTELOPE VALLEY

Defined on the north and east by the county line; on the south and west by the 4500 foot contour.

CAZ288 – SANTA CLARITA VALLEY

Defined in all directions by the 1500 foot contour.
