## New Afloat System Streamlines Tracking of Personnel and Training

NTMPS Afloat (NAFL) is a stand-alone, Microsoft Access-based application that allows shipboard Sailors to retrieve personnel and training data from the Navy Training Management Planning System (NTMPS) database and store it for later use offline. It is tailored to individual sea-going units and reduces the Internet connectivity requirements.

NAFL was developed in response to a Fleet Forces Command tasking for a personnel and

training reporting system responsive to the special needs of sea-going units. NAFL currently provides users information on courses, personnel, and training accomplishments and requirements and can be downloaded whenever a unit has Internet connectivity.

Users must have a current account with the Fleet Training Management Planning System (FLTMPS), an NTMPS program for afloat users, to access NAFL. Requests for a FLTMPS account can be made by going to the NTMPS Web site (<a href="http://ntmps.navy.mil/">http://ntmps.navy.mil/</a>) and selecting the "Application Form" link.
