




# Regulations

## **Problems**

Marine Protected Areas are not <u>specific</u> enough to replenish our damaged ecosystem

**Problems with MPA regulations:** 

- Enforcement
- Few specific regulations
- The established community
- Federal/State jurisdiction makes it difficult to protect


