ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

On February 11, 2004, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings. The parties moved to stay proceedings for four months pending ongoing settlement negotiations. This extension will be granted; however, as this case has been ongoing for over a year, the hearing will begin at the end of this stay. The prehearing conference scheduled for March 1-2, 2004 in San Francisco is hereby cancelled. The parties are strongly encouraged to continue settlement negotiations. The hearing will be set to begin on July 12, 2004.¹ The parties will file status reports every forty-five days from the date of this Order.
