They realize it is necessary to obtain meaningful employment in the facility, and on the streets. It created a sense of urgency that may not be so prevalent if not for programming that is available to the women before their release."

I have obtained training in a field in which my felony will not hinder me from succeeding upon release. It has given me the opportunity to provide monetary assistance for my children and family as well as being self-sufficient while I am incarcerated.

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Clear conduct is a requirement for this position, and acts as an incentive to women who desire to become an employee of ____. The program is available to any inmate who meets the qualifications despite the length of their sentence, unlike work release. On-site programming has multiple benefits for the inmates, the facility, and the company we work for. In the past, facility programming has not always "opened doors" for employment opportunities on the streets. I am thankful telemarketing was introduced in this facility, because it a field men and women like myself can master while incarcerated, and use the skills and experience upon release. It is an excellent choice for inmate work programs. I enjoy my position. I have gained my self-esteem once again. Release no longer seems so full of uncertainties.
