The DEQ agreed that a laboratory was a process and that one satellite accumulation area for the laboratory was compliant. Numerous types of hazardous wastes could be collected in different locations in the laboratory as long as an overall limit of 55 gallons of waste (1 quart for acute hazardous waste) was respected. During discussions, the DEQ likened the practice to an automotive shop. The automotive shop would be a single process with numerous activities happening. Rags, paints, and still bottoms are three wastes that could be generated by this process and all could be put into satellite accumulation. The DEQ and DOE agreed there was not an issue with the current INEEL practice of using a single satellite accumulation area in a laboratory setting so long as the process, that is the operation of the laboratory, was ongoing.
