The outer boundary of the underserved area beginning at the northern tip is as follows:

The Northeastern tip of the underserved area: Starting point is Hopewell Avenue. Travel south on Hopewell Avenue and then move east on Route 65, which runs parallel to Ohio River Boulevard and Route 51. The outer boundary shifts due east at 24th street in Ambridge and turns into Brietenstein Rd. Follow Brietenstein Rd until you can travel south on Ridge Rd. Ridge Road will loop around and then follow Beaver Road – southwest. Continuing along census track 6040, follow Spruce Street south to Myrtle and connect with Larch St. Larch St. becomes Clinton St. and turns into Wilson Ave. Travel Southwest on Wilson to Valley Rd. then southeast on Beech St. This is the dividing line between census tracks 4480 – included in the qualifying area and 4470, which is not in the proposed area. This boundary runs parallel with Beaver Rd and shifts slightly Northeast at Camp meeting Rd. The boundary between census tracks 4480, 4470 and 4460 comes to a point and then shifts southwest and intersects Ohio River Boulevard.
