Continuing South on this boundary, you'll intersect Crane Ave and eventually loop onto West Liberty Avenue and back onto Saw Mill Run Boulevard to then travel on the outerboundary of tract 1809 and turn east on Bausman St. Bausman Street will meet Mathews avenue and Beltzhoover Avenue.
