

TREATY ON FISHERIES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF CERTAIN PACIFIC ISLAND STATES AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE PACIFIC ISLAND STATES party to this Treaty and the Government of the United States of America:

Vessel operators who wish to participate in the Treaty fishery must submit annual license and registration applications, VMS registration applications, and periodic written reports of catch and unloading of fish from a licensed vessel. The information collected is submitted to the Forum Fisheries Agency (FFA) through the U.S. government (National Marine Fisheries Service [NMFS]). For further reporting requirements under the Pacific Tuna Act, contact National Marine Fisheries Service at the address below.
