## **EVIDENTIARY MATTERS HOG 12 through HOG 15**

Evidentiary and procedural matters: Representation hearings are considered investigatory and not adversarial in nature. At the same time, such hearings are formal proceedings. Their purpose is to develop a full and complete factual record upon which the Regional Director may base a decision. The rules of relevancy and materiality are paramount. There is no burden of proof except in objections cases (see HOG 36 for Hearings on Election Objections). The technical rules of evidence are followed only to maintain the formality of the proceedings. They are not used for the purpose of excluding evidence.

*HOG 12 through 31* are designed to address evidentiary and procedural considerations which the Hearing Officer may confront at any time during the course of the hearing process.
