#### I. GENERAL INFORMATION

#### A. Background:

This Program Memorandum (PM) serves two purposes. It contains the updated Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes for ASCs for services performed on or after **January 1**, **2004**, along with their payment groups. It also provides instructions for contractors to retrieve the new data via the CMS Mainframe Telecommunications System on or after the specified retrieval date.

The CMS' Division of Data Systems (DDS) will release the files listed below. This PM provides contractors with file names and instructions on how to retrieve these files from the CMS Mainframe Telecommunications System.

#### B. Policy:

The deletions from and additions to the ASC list are the result of changes in the American Medical Association (AMA) Physician's Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) for 2004. The attachment containing the deletions and additions is being sent as a Word document attached to this instruction.

These changes are confidential and shall not be publicized until after the publication of the AMA's 2004 CPT-4 codes which usually occurs by the first of November.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECEIVING 2004 AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTER (ASC) HCPC CODE CHANGES VIA CMS' MAINFRAME TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM

Listed below are instructions for receiving the 2004 ASC Code HCPCS additions, deletions and master listing along with their respective payment groups via the CMS mainframe telecommunications system. In order not to incur additional transmission cost, transmission must occur during the evening hours, specifically after 8:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time (EST).

Listed below are the most common problems encountered when carriers/intermediaries receive data via the CMS mainframe telecommunications system:

- o Omission or change of NEWNAME parameter. Omission of this parameter makes it extremely difficult and cumbersome for CMS to access CMTS log to verify transmission success/failure. See the following NEWNAME parameters:
- o Omission or change of STARTT parameter. This parameter establishes the starting time for the batch job. As stated earlier, transmission must occur during the evening hours. Setting the STARTT to 20:00:00 hours assures that transmission will not commence prior to 8:00 PM EST.

The following is the JCL required for setting up a CMTS transmission of the 2004 Part B Pricing Files file from the CMS Data Center.
