Public Migratory and Upland Game Hunting Area Rules and Regulations

Area Closed at Noon: No afternoon hunting.

 Legal shooting hours are from one-half hour before sunrise to noon.

All Parties Must Sign In:

- Hunters are to log in and out daily.
- All minors must be accompanied by an adult.

Hunting of Pheasant, Quail, Dove, Ducks, Geese and Sandhill Cranes is permitted on designated areas (see map) subject to the following conditions:

Hunting is restricted to the area bounded by the refuge boundary to the west and north. The east boundary is the western sides of units A & B. The south boundary is 150 yards north of State Hwy 11. 150 yards north of State Hwy 11 is a retrieval zone only.


Hunters should consult ODWC's hunt brochures for further regulations.





All State regulations apply except those as listed below:

- No rifles or handguns allowed in the hunt area.
- Federally approved nontoxic shot only. Hunters can not be in possession of shot shells loaded with shot other than federally approved nontoxic shot while in the hunting area.
- Decoys and materials brought into the refuge for blind construction must be removed at the end of every hunt day.
- All vehicles must be parked in designated refuge-access parking areas.
- All hunting closed during state rifle deer season.

Deer hunting locations vary and the location of the hunter's tract is only available at the mandatory orientation on the day that the hunt begins.

Controlled Deer Hunting Rules and Regulations

Deer hunts are administered in cooperation with the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation. Deer hunters are drawn by ODWC. For details about applications, contact ODWC.

Only deer are legal under specific permits.

Legal spikes can have a 3/4 " or less forked tine - brow tines are not included.

Shooting hours are 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.

Permanent blinds/stands are not permitted.

Deer must be checked in as soon as possible - same day.

Hunters must check in and out daily.
