

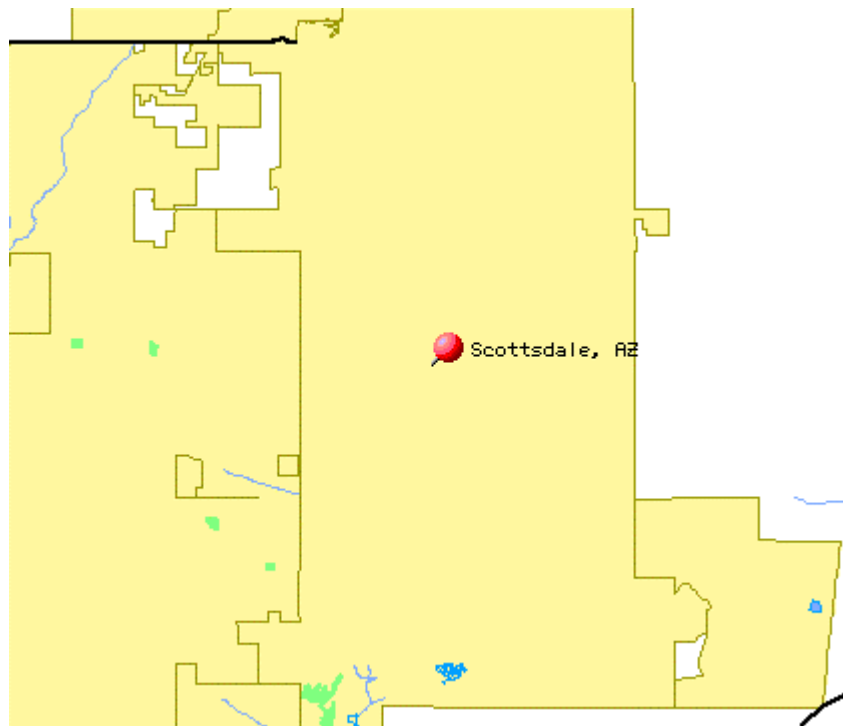

- Population- 206,280 (1999)² 130,069 (1990 Census)

- Race- 96.0% White, 0.8% Black, 0.6% American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut, 1.2% Asian or Pacific Islander, 1.4% other.

Crime and Drug-Related Crime

- During 1999, there were approximately 8,600 crime index offenses known to the police in Scottsdale.⁴

Enforcement

- In FY 1999/2000, Scottsdale Police Department received funding for 455 full time positions and 5 part-time positions. Full-time positions have been approved to increase in FY 2000/2001 to 486 positions.⁵

Corrections

- As of March 31, 2000, 59.3% of Arizona inmates were in the custody of Maricopa County correctional authorities.⁶
