

- ➤ Hennepin County Race/Ethnicity (1990): 89.3% white; 5.8% black; 1.4% American Indian, Eskimo, or Aleut; 2.9% Asian/Pacific Islander; 0.5% other race; 1.4% Hispanic.<sup>4</sup>

### **Crime and Drug-Related Crime**<sup>6</sup>

- ➤ In 1999, the Edina Police Department responded to 24,957 calls for service and made 1.164 arrests.
- At this time, there were 30 narcotic offenses known to the police in Edina.

#### **Enforcement**

As of October 31, 1998, there was a total of 64 full-time police employees in Edina. 49 of these employees were officers, and the remainder of these employees were civilians.<sup>7</sup>
