- Population: 15,849 (1990 Census)
- County: Bristol
- Bristol County Population: 49,114 (1998 estimate)

Politics²

- The Town of Barrington's government consists of 5 elected council members headed by a Council President and 1 appointed Town Manager.
- The Town Manager is appointed by the Town Council and is the head of the Administrative branch of Barrington's government.

Crime and Drug-Related Crime³

- In 1998 there were 407 index crime offenses known to the Barrington Police Department.
