Homelessness Awareness Week 2004

National Hunger and Homelessness Awareness Week was first publicized and promoted as a national event by the National Student Campaign Against Hunger and Homelessness in 1988. Hunger and Homelessness Week is the week prior to Thanksgiving each year. This year's dates are November 15-19, 2004.
