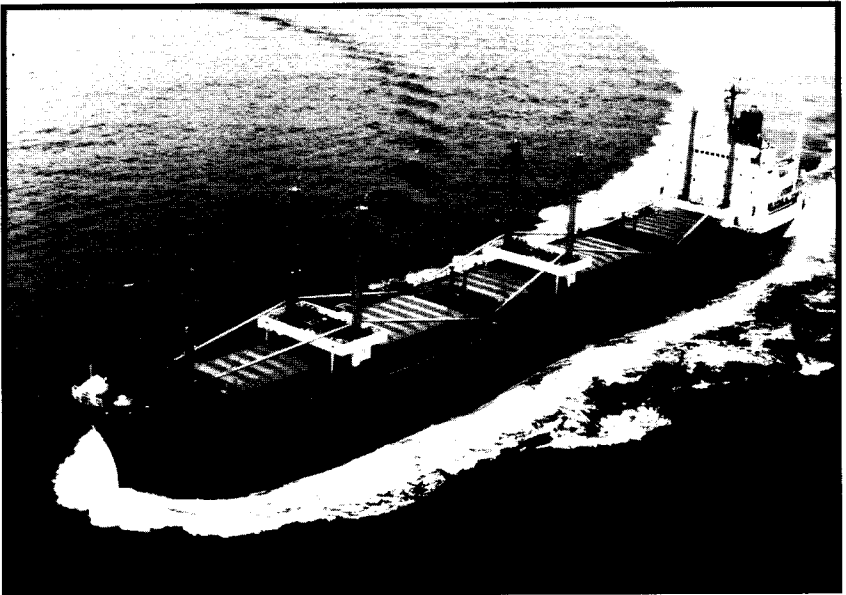

MARITIME MANAGEMENT AND TRADE ORGANIZATIONS

AMERICAN MARITIME OFFICERS SERVICE (AMOS)

The American Maritime Officers Service, organized in 1975, represents U.S.-flag vessel operators on all U.S. coasts. Its primary purpose is to encourage the development of a strong and competitive U.S.-flag merchant marine.

AMERICAN WATERWAYS OPERATORS, INC. (AWO)

The American Waterways Operators, incorporated in 1944, represents the national interests of domestic maritime transportation, primarily the barge and towing industry. The membership of AWO includes all segments of the inland and coastal barge and towing industry including tugboat, towboat, and barge operators, and the shipyards that build and repair the industry's vessels. The primary task of AWO is to function as a voice for the collective interests of its varied member organizations.

AMERICAN MARITIME ASSOCIATION (AMA)

The American Maritime Association represents unsubsidized ocean carriers. The AMA conducts negotiations for member companies with the SIU. Agreements are concluded in the form of memoranda of understanding. Agreements are then prepared for signature by each member company. The authority to accept or decline a settlement is retained by member companies individually.

CHAMBER OF SHIPPING OF AMERICA

The former American Institute of Merchant Shipping was established in January 1969 to promote new programs needed for a modern and efficient U.S.-flag merchant marine fleet. The organization included companies who were formerly members of the American Merchant Marine Institute, Pacific American Steamship Association and the Committee of American Steamship Lines. USCS membership is open to all owners and operators of U.S.-flag tankers, dry bulk carriers, containerships, and other ocean-going vessels.

LAKE CARRIERS' ASSOCIATION (LCA)

Lake Carriers' Association represents most U.S.-flag fleets operating dry- and liquid-bulk cargo vessels on the Great Lakes. Founded in 1880, LCA represents the common interests of its member fleets, particularly as they relate to legislative and regulatory affairs. Additionally, the Association is the primary source of statistical information concerning Great Lakes shipping.

MARITIME SERVICE COMMITTEE, INC. (MSC)

The Maritime Service Committee represents subsidized owners and operators of oceangoing dry cargo vessels on the Atlantic and Gulf Coasts for negotiations with maritime labor unions. The MSC has no authority to bind any member company to a contract. Each member company retains authority to sign the final agreement.

PACIFIC MARITIME ASSOCIATION (PMA)

The Pacific Maritime Association, founded in 1949, consists of steamship, terminal and stevedoring companies on the West Coast. PMA represents member stevedoring companies in all labor negotiations. The Shoreside Division negotiates with the International Longshore and Warehouse Union (ILWU) for companies employing shoreside personnel. PMA membership does not include tanker operators. PMA is given the authority by member stevedoring companies to negotiate binding contracts.

TANKER SERVICE COMMITTEE, INC. (TSC)

The Tanker Service Committee negotiates for member companies who own and/or operate tankers. It also permits membership by companies who negotiate directly with Independent Tanker Officers' and Tankermen's Associations.

MARITIME SEAFARING LABOR ORGANIZATIONS

AMERICAN RADIO ASSOCIATION (ARA)

The ARA represents ships' radio officers. Collective bargaining agreements cover jobs aboard ships operated by steamship companies on the Atlantic, Gulf and Pacific Coasts. The ARA constitutes the Marine Electronics Division of the ILA.

AMERICAN MARITIME OFFICERS (AMO)

The AMO represents licensed ships' officers employed on U.S.-flag oceangoing, Great Lakes and inland waterways vessels.

INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF MASTERS, MATES AND PILOTS (MMP)

The MMP represents ships' officers. Collective bargaining agreements between the MMP and ship operators are maintained on a industry-wide basis for the Atlantic, Gulf and Pacific Coasts. MMP also has divisions representing pilots and deck officers in coastal areas. The MMP is the International Marine Division of the International Longshoremen's Association, AFL-CIO.

NATIONAL MARINE ENGINEERS' BENEFICIAL ASSOCIATION (MEBA)

District No. 1 MEBA represents predominantly licensed engineers on the Atlantic, Gulf and Pacific Coasts.

NATIONAL MARITIME UNION OF AMERICA (NMU)

The NMU represents unlicensed personnel of the deck, engine and stewards departments.

SEAFARERS INTERNATIONAL UNION OF NORTH AMERICA (SIUNA)

The SIUNA consists of three autonomous affiliates representing unlicensed personnel. The Seafarers International Union, Atlantic, Gulf, Lakes and Inland Waters District (SIU) represents unlicensed personnel of the deck, engine and stewards departments. Collective bargaining agreements are maintained with steamship companies operating on the Atlantic, Gulf, and Pacific Coasts.

The Sailors Union of the Pacific (SUP) represents unlicensed personnel of the deck department on Pacific Coast company dry cargo ships and all three departments on some tankers.

The Marine Firemen's Union (MFU) represents unlicensed personnel of the engine department on Pacific Coast company ships.

Interchange of personnel of the various SIUNA affiliates provides a broader employment potential for the members of the individual affiliates. Field offices and employment centers are administered jointly by the SIUNA affiliates on the Atlantic, Gulf and Pacific Coasts.

SEAFARERS MARITIME UNION (SMU)

The SMU was organized jointly by the Seafarers International Union and American Maritime Officers. The SMU represents unlicensed personnel and radio officers.

SUP, MFU, and SIU Cooks, which formerly negotiated with Pacific Maritime Association (PMA), now negotiate with individual West Coast operators.
