

21st CENTURY EXPLORING PARENTING PRE-INSTITUTE TRAINING OVERVIEW

A training session on the 21st Century Exploring Parenting program, with special emphasis on literacy issues and working with fathers, will be held Monday, June 14, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Tuesday through Thursday, June 15-17, from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. The goals of 21st Century Exploring Parenting are to get to know yourself better, to get to know your child better, and to use this knowledge in making decisions about how to raise your child. Depending on demand, the training may also be offered in Spanish.

The first 100 Head Start/Early Head Start programs that enroll two persons for the Institute and the pre-Institute training will be accepted. This team of two will then be responsible for returning to their local community and sharing the 21st Century Exploring Parenting program with Head Start parents.

There is an additional registration charge of \$50 per person to attend the 21st Century Exploring Parenting training, which includes lunch on Monday and curriculum materials with video. Participants accepted into the training (on a first-come-first-served basis) will be notified and billed in advance of the Institute. Note that participants must send a team of two individuals for arrival on Sunday, June 13, as Monday's session begins at 8:30 a.m.

BY CAR, BUS, & TRAIN

Dallas is easy to get to from most major cities in the region, thanks to its location at the intersection of a number of major crossroads. Dallas can be conveniently accessed from four major highways, including US-75, I-45, I-35, and I-30.

Greyhound long-distance buses operate from the 24-hour Greyhound bus terminal located at 205 S. Lamar. For more information, please call 800-229-9424 or visit www.greyhound.com.

Amtrak services cover long-distance routes to Dallas via the Texas Eagle Train. The train station is located at 400 S. Houston Street. For more information, please call 800-872-7245 or visit www.amtrak.com.

Getting Around

TAXI & AIRPORT SHUTTLE SERVICES

Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW)

Taxi service is available from the upper level of each terminal. The average one-way fare to downtown Dallas is \$38. Shuttle bus service to or from DFW is provided 24-hours a day by SuperShuttle. The average one-way fare to downtown Dallas is \$20. Twenty-four hour advance notice is required. For additional SuperShuttle information, call 800-258-3826 or visit www.supershuttle.com.

Dallas Love Field Airport (DAL)

Taxi service is provided on the upper level across the street from the baggage claim wing of the main terminal building. The average one-way fare to downtown Dallas is \$18. Shuttle bus service to and from DAL is provided by SuperShuttle. The average one-way fare to downtown Dallas is \$15. Twenty-four hour advance notice is required. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

Public transportation is provided by the **Dallas Area Rapid Transit** (**DART**) light rail system. The 44-mile DART rail system provides fast, convenient service to the Dallas Convention Center, area hotels, and shopping and entertainment destinations. For route and schedule information, call the Transit Department's Customer Service Center at 214-979-1111 or visit www.dart.org.

The Trinity Railway Express (TRE) transports visitors from downtown Union Station to DFW Airport. Shuttle routes operate from CentrePort/DFW Airport Station, delivering passengers directly to their terminals. One route travels to Terminals A and C; the other serves Terminals B and E. Shuttles are scheduled to meet all trains, departing every 15 minutes, Monday through Saturday. No regularly scheduled service is available on Sunday. Union Station is located a few blocks from the Hyatt Regency in downtown Dallas. Located approximately one mile from the Convention Center, the Adam's Mark Dallas Hotel will serve as the Institute Headquarters. The hotel is located in the center of Dallas' downtown arts and financial district, within walking distance of the Dallas Museum of Art, Meyerson Symphony Center, and the Majestic Theatre. The Adam's Mark, the largest hotel in Dallas, features five restaurants and amenities including a fully equipped health club, indoor and outdoor pools, saunas, and whirlpools. The hotel is located approximately 22 miles from DFW International Airport and 12 miles from DAL Airport.

Hyatt Regency Dallas 300 Reunion Boulevard \$95	\$120	\$145	\$170
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Located within two blocks of the Convention Center, the Hyatt Regency Dallas features an 18-story atrium, two lounges, and three restaurants, including Antares, a revolving New American restaurant atop Reunion Tower. The hotel offers a newly-renovated fitness center, outdoor pool, and jacuzzi. An underground concourse connects the hotel to Union Station, providing access to various parts of Dallas via the light and commuter rail systems. The hotel is located approximately 23 miles from DFW International Airport and 10 miles from DAL Airport.

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The Renaissance Dallas Hotel is located in the heart of the Dallas Market Center, close to downtown and three miles from the Convention Center. The hotel features two restaurants and is located minutes from the West End Marketplace, Big "D" sporting arenas, and the Kennedy Museum. Amenities include a fully-equipped health club, an outdoor heated pool, whirlpool, sauna, and steam room. The hotel is located 15 miles from DFW International Airport and 8 miles from DAL Airport.

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The Wyndham is approximately three miles from the Convention Center and is located on 45 lush acres just outside of downtown Dallas. The hotel features ten retail boutiques and shops, six lounges, and five restaurants, including the five-star Nana restaurant. Amenities include a full-service health club and spa, three swimming pools, and a private seven-acre park. The hotel is located approximately 18 miles from DFW International Airport and 8 miles from DAL Airport.

- All hotel room charges are subject to a 15 percent hotel tax.
- A deposit equal to one night's room and tax is required to guarantee your reservation. Check, money order, American Express, Discover, Visa, or MasterCard are accepted for deposit. 
