

The boundaries of the regular blocks are 4,800 international meters on a side and contain 2,304 hectares. The regular boundaries are defined in terms of X and Y coordinates of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid System based on the Geodetic Reference System (GRS) 1980 Ellipsoid.

Although not shown, the 200 nautical mile Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) Limit lies within this diagram.

The coordinate values appearing on this document were derived using NAD 83/WGS 84.


The areas of the fractional blocks abutting the Exclusive Economic Zone Limit and the Limit of Protraction line have been determined and are as depicted on the Supplemental Official OCS Block Diagrams (SOBD's). Consult the SOBD's for official descriptions and approval dates.


Legend: Exclusive Economic Zone Limit Limit of Protraction
