Working in partnership with Department of Energy (DOE) Program Offices, the Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI) has developed a set of *Subject Portals* for accessing a diverse group of information sources to include DOE scientific and technical reports, journal literature, and information contained in database(s) selected by Program Offices.

Key Features

New Releases

The New Releases feature of *Subject Portals* provides a list (compiled by running a predefined subject search) of recently available items (updated biweekly) in the discipline. Users can review this list for items of interest and can, in the case of DOE technical reports, access the full text of items of interest simply by clicking on the appropriate icon.

Distributed Searching

The Distributed Searching feature of *Subject Portals* provides users the opportunity to parallel search across a selected set of heterogeneous databases, no matter where the data resides. This specific search produces results that researchers and the public can use to access additional full text when available.
