Subj: EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide procedures and guidelines for notifying staff personnel in emergencies.

2. Cancellation. COMSCINST 12610.1.

3. <u>Information</u>. Potentially severe winter weather conditions make it necessary to establish a system for relaying information to all staff personnel during off-duty hours.

4. <u>Action</u>. In the event that an announcement has to be passed to the workforce, the duty officer will advise command staff personnel, (immediate staffs of the Commander and Deputy Commander) and COMSC (N1). N1 will then pass the message to each of the following:

a. Each of these individuals will then be responsible for notifying all subordinates within his/her office, either directly or through subordinate supervisors.

b. This system will be used only for situations outside the norm, as when, for example, the Commander wants an announcement passed on. Employees should continue to listen for and abide by general announcements on the news concerning office opening/closing.
