Replies to oppositions must be filed no later than **May 17, 2004**, five (5) business days after the filing date for oppositions. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.2108(c). All pleadings filed regarding the Paging long-form applications should refer to **Report No. AUC-48 (Auction No. 48)**, as well as to the specific FCC file number of the individual application.

See 47 C.F.R. § 1.2109(a). Licenses will be awarded upon the full and timely payment of the winning bids and any applicable late fees.
